# COUNCIL CHAPLAIN'S CORNER



#### Some Interesting points on why we believe


- 1. A Public Execution Assured us of His Death: After being humiliated, insulted, spat upon, whipped, beaten and then hung on a cross His executioners claimed victory by declaring Him dead. Just to be sure they thrust a spear into His side.
- 2. A High Official Secured The Gravesite: Pilate ordered the official seal of Rome to be attached to the tomb. To enforce the order soldiers stood guard. The Roman guards knew the penalty of falling asleep while on watch would be death.
- 3. In Spite Of the Guards the Tomb Was Found Empty: On the morning after the Sabbath the huge stone had been rolled away and the body of Jesus was gone. The guards swore they had fainted after seeing a supernatural being. They were paid to keep this quiet and instead say the disciples had stolen the body.
- 4. He Was Seen Alive By Many: I Corinthians 15:5-8 tells us that He was seen by Peter and the twelve apostles. More than 500 other people saw Him over a period of 40 days including Paul and James. Acts 1:3 He was here for 40 days speaking to the apostles about the Kingdom of God.
- 5. Jewish Believers Changed Their Day Of Worship: The Sabbath day was basic to the Jewish way of life. If you didn't honor the Sabbath you were guilty of breaking the Law of Moses. Yet Jewish followers of Christ changed their day of worship to the same day as the Gentiles. The first day of the week, the day they believed Christ rose from the dead.
- 6. Although It Was Unexpected It Was Clearly Predicted: The disciples were caught off guard. They expected their Messiah to restore the kingdom to Israel. They overlooked the prophet Isaiah's prediction of a suffering servant who would bear the sins of Israel, being led like a lamb to the slaughter, before God prolonged His days. Isaiah: 53-10
- 7. His Apostles Were Dramatically Changed: After Judas one of Christ's apostles had betrayed Him the other apostles ran for their lives. Even Peter who earlier had insisted that he was ready to die for his teacher, lost heart and denied that he ever knew Jesus. But after the resurrection the apostles went through a dramatic change. Within a few weeks they were willing to stand up to the ones who had crucified Christ. They became unstoppable in their determination to sacrifice everything for the one they called Savior and Lord. They were imprisoned, beaten and in Acts 5:29 told the Jewish leaders "we will obey God rather than men."



#### Did You Know?

Since 1973, more than 56 million preborn babies have been destroyed due to the legalization of abortion in the United States. That's more people than the entire population of Spain.

Given the current abortion rate, 1 baby is aborted every 30 seconds and 120 babies are aborted every hour. That means that by the time you finish reading this anti-abortion article dozens more preborn babies will be lost. And that's just in the United States. The volume of death represented by abortion is staggering.

Abortion is killing on a genocidal scale.

#### **Abortion Kills Mothers**

The procedure of abortion is highly unregulated compared with other invasive medical procedures. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports [http://www.cdc.gov/mmwr/preview/mmwrhtml/ss6311a1.htm?s\_cid=ss6311a1\_w] that from 1973 to 2010 over 400 women who underwent legal abortions in the U.S. were killed by the procedure. You may read our abortion articles to learn more.

Dr. Janet Daling and her colleagues conducted a study funded by the National Cancer Institute to explore the connection between abortion and breast cancer. They found [http://www.aaplog.org/position-and-papers/partial-birth-abortion/aaplog-statement-on-the-association-of-induced-abortion-and-the-subsequent-development-of-breast-cancer/] that a woman's risk of developing breast cancer was 50% higher if she had had an abortion. If a woman had had an abortion in her teenage years, then the risk was 100% higher. Get more details on the abortion-breast cancer link from our articles on abortion.

Clearly, if the number of women who have lost their lives to breast cancer that developed as a consequence of a past abortion were included among maternal deaths owing to legal abortion, the death toll for mothers who choose to terminate their pregnancies would be much higher.

#### The Pitfalls of Replacing Coverage

You know the old saying, "the grass seems greener on the other side of the fence," but we all know that it rarely is. The same holds true when it comes to replacing your existing Knights of Columbus life insurance with coverage offered by another company. Perceptions are deceiving. All these factors can affect the amount of coverage you'll get for your premium dollar.

If someone encourages you to replace — or worse, drop — your existing coverage, please call me. I'll show you how your existing coverage is working for you and why replacement is rarely in your best interest.
