





A Talk by Marco Rubio



According to Rubio all the arguments in favor of abortion can easily be knocked down. The most common of these is the argument that a woman has the right to do what she pleases with her body. But there is another right, the right to live. And so when you analyze this issue on a pro-life vs. pro-choice, what we basically have are two rights that are in conflict with each other, and we as a society must decide what to do when two rights are in conflict with each other. The pro-choice community argues that we have the right to choose because the unborn is not viable on its own. However that is not a good argument for abortion either because a 6 month old, a 1 year old a 2 year old child is not viable without their mother either. Some would jokingly argue that even a 16-year-old should not be left alone without their mother.

Rubio insisted that in the struggle between the rights of the mother and the rights of the unborn, the deck is stacked against the unborn because they cannot vote. He urged the audience to "use your voice for those who cannot speak."




