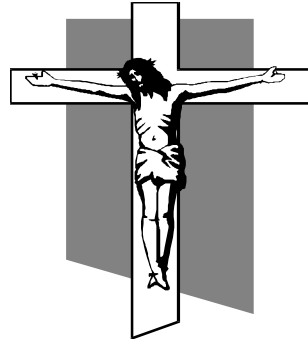

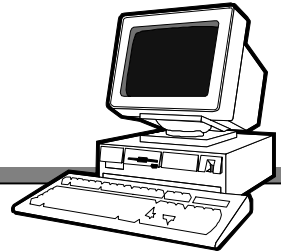
Should We Just Expect Good ?

In the fall of 1982 Deborah Kiley set out with three others to deliver a 58-foot yacht called Trashman from Maine to Florida. Off the coast of North Carolina they encountered gale winds and huge waves that sank their boat in 2 minutes. After 4 days of fighting off sharks in a small rubber dinghy without fresh water or food. Two of the young men aboard shouted curses at God and because of their thirst they drank sea water which caused them to become delirious and jump overboard, they were eaten by sharks. Debbie despite how tired she was silently recited the Lords Prayer over and over and asked God to teach her through this crisis.

We all handle crisis differently. When Job was hit with so many trials in his life. He was tempted to give up but instead he prayed (Job 2:10) *"Should we just accept good from God and not expect some adversity?"* (Job 42:12-16) *Job had lost everything but because of his faithfulness he was given fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels a thousand yoke of oxen and a thousand donkeys. He also had seven sons and seven daughters. After this Job lived to see his children and their children to the fourth generation. And so he died, old and full of years.*

God does not allow us to suffer for no reason, and even though the reason may be hidden in the mystery of His divine purpose never for us to know in this life- we must trust in Him as the God who does only what is right. 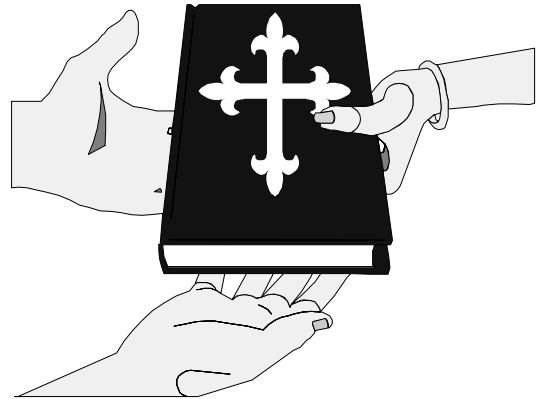

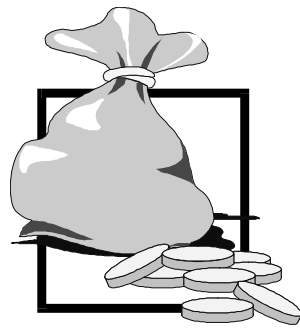

I hope to see all of you at the monthly business meetings.

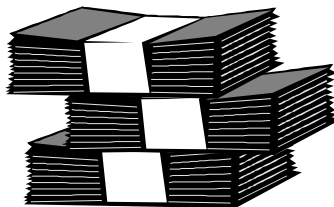

“I just wanted to let you know you’ve touched my heart. For years, to many years to count I murdered countless children, up until 3 months ago that is. I believed I was doing what was best at the time. I worked for Planned Parenthood.

I became hardened and cold to the fact I was killing children. How I, a physician who had taken an oath to preserve life can perform abortions, can actually kill defenseless unborn babies, literally rip them out in many pieces from the womb of the mother is beyond me. But I see it now. Partial Birth abortions was my living.

Finally one day, something hit me and my hard heart began to soften. After receiving a pro-life tract and actually reading it I got angry but I didn’t throw it away. I broke down that day and felt like I had died inside. Millions of emotions came at me and I had a weight lifted off my shoulders. It was so heavy worse than any depression I had ever felt. I felt like for every baby I had taken from this world a part of me died as well. I cry as I write this. I cry for the mothers and the fathers who decided because of “choice” they would kill their children. I cry for the babies who were brutally murdered at my hand. It takes a lot to admit that. A LOT.

Where is the church, the outreach groups? Get out there! Do something Please! Don’t say “it isn’t my field.” Shouldn’t it be every moral persons responsibility to defend the defenseless? And don’t tell me pro-life outreach doesn’t work or tracts don’t help. It certainly did for me. There is not a day that goes by now, where my heart is not heavy with grief or I don’t get angry. I can only hope God can forgive me. If anyone deserves a hell it’s the one who murders children.

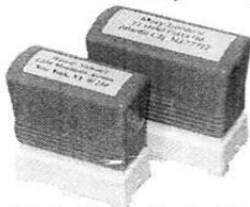
