I thought we were going to hold our Recruitment Drive in March, I was mistaken, it will be held this month on April 16th and 17th. But my challenge is still good.

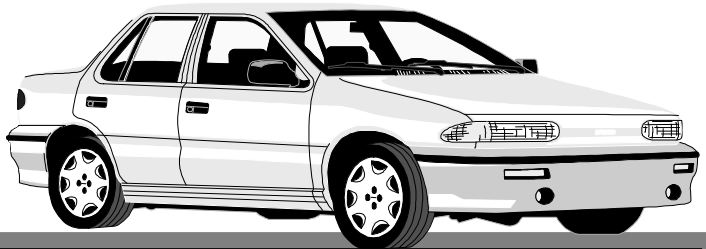

I would like to share with you a prayer that I say daily, Novena to the Holy Spirit. You may find it uplifting during the Easter Season. Brother Ray Richmond gave it to me some years ago, and I love it. Brother Carlos Ramirez and other Knights say it too.

In researching the prayer, I learned that it originated with Brother George E. Schulhoff, former Chancellor of the Norwood Council Knights of Columbus. If you have access to the internet, you can go to the website aoths.org (Apostles of the Holy Spirit.) Schulhoff founded the Apostles of the Holy Spirit in August 1948. He owned a Hardware Store and funded it with his own money. You can read about the history on the website. 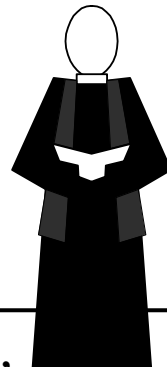
