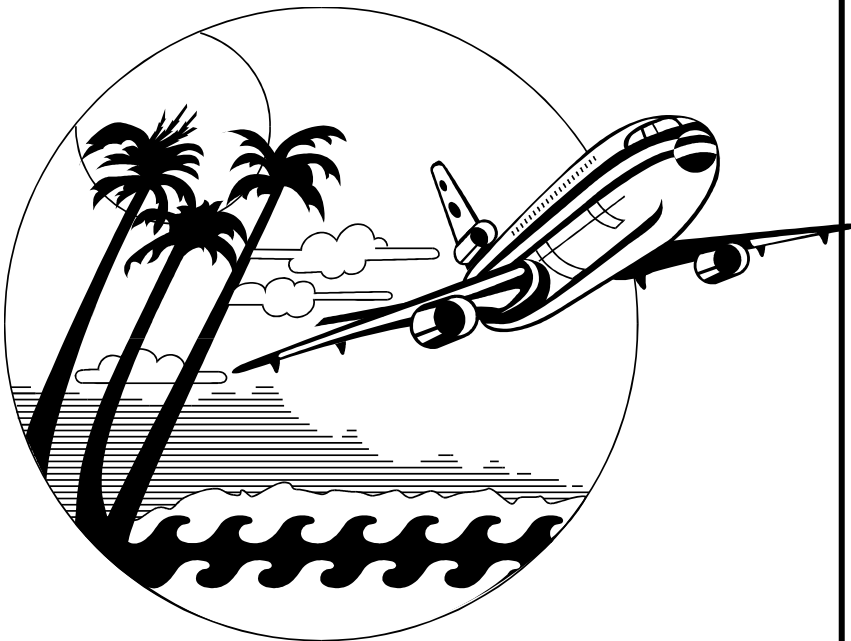
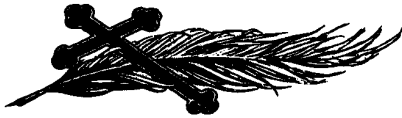

Brother Knights,

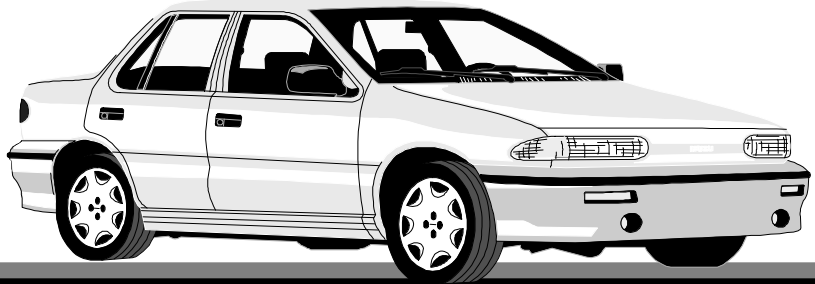

Dear friends are a blessing from God in this life and in the next! On Friday, July 14 I lost two dear friends, brother knight Gilbert Montoya and Irene Macik, both in their 90's.

Brother Gil was originally from Colorado, and I called him "cowboy", because he reminded me of the original cowboys, the Spanish vaqueros. Gil drove a 1/2 car, 1/2 truck, which he loved and which his good friend Curtiss took over and is restoring. Gil and Mary, his wife, did so much for the Knights and for St. Irenaeus. For years they helped bring joy by preparing for pot lucks and holiday celebrations. For years Gil opened and closed St. Irenaeus Church. He helped prepare for Christmas with the trees and our Knights of Columbus manger scene. I am sure our brother knights have many more stories of Gil and Mary's contributions. Brothers Carlos and Fred and I got to bring Holy Communion to Gil and Mary when Gil was homebound.

My wife Julie and I were blessed with bringing Holy Communion too to Irene for years. Brother Leo Fernandez introduced me to Irene and her husband John when he brought Communion to them. John, the love of Irene's life, died a few years ago. Irene lost her mother when Irene was just a girl and had to become mom to her siblings. John was a World War II hero who survived a bloody attack in France. Irene was an artist and taught art. She befriended Walter and Cordelia Knott when Mr. Knott stopped by to see her painting the little church at Knott's Berry Farm. Irene lived through the Great Depression, as did Gilbert and Mary. She became legally blind and suffered from congestive heart failure. Gil also suffered heart problems. Both Irene and Gil offered their suffering to Christ and still managed to live with joy in their hearts.

Yes, we'll miss them both, but we know in our hearts that they are both closer now to our Lord and united with their loved ones. Let us pray for them and for their intercession for us. May they rest in eternal happiness and joy! Good night, Irene. Good knight, Gil!

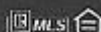
