The June/July 2018 KNIGHTLINE (available on www.kofc.org) outlines the 32 Recommended Programs of Faith In Action on page 3.

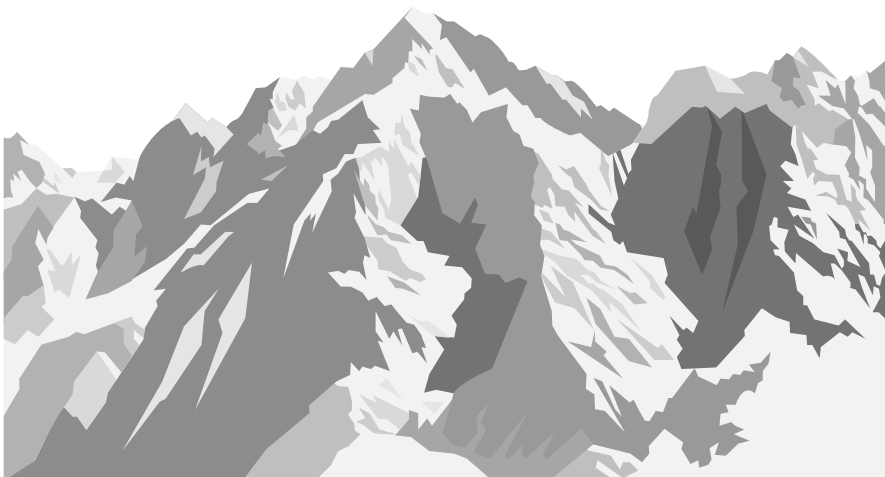
