I hope everybody is having a nice and relaxing summer. School is still out, children at home. Enjoy your family and spend good and fun times with them.




2:Then I, John saw the holy city. New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.




Why Help the Presentation Sisters
