



KEN'S GRIN

It is with heavy heart and through tearful eyes that I reflect on Ken Peterson (July 14, 1939 to June 28, 2021.) I learned of Ken's death through an email on June 28, 2021 while on vacation in Monterey, CA. On Thursday, July 15 at 7 pm, St. Irenaeus Church held a Celebration and Remembrance of Ken. Deacons Jerry and Del led the service.

Deacon Jerry called Ken a "good man," the highest compliment he could give anyone. He further reflected that he hated to see such a good person leave this Earth, where we so sorely need good folks. Deacon Jerry was most struck by Ken's infectious, ever-present smile. Next to the podium where the deacon spoke hung Ken's naval uniform complete with cap and tie.

Following his eulogy, we prayed for Ken and his family. Five of us Knights of Columbus led the rosary while the deacons prefaced each decade with its meaning and connection to Ken. My heart pounded as I led the mystery of Mary's Assumption into Heaven. I looked out over the large crowd of family and friends and felt the love Ken had shared with them.

Just before the service ended, Ken's oldest son and youngest son and two grandchildren shared their heartfelt reflections on Ken. One spoke of "Ken's grin." Ken and his wife Kay together had helped create this loving family and nurture them well. Each family member seemed to have followed Ken and Kay in serving Christ, their neighbors and all the People of God. With COVID-19 restrictions relaxed, all of us two hundred or so grievers got to hug or shake hands with Ken's family, especially Kay!

The next day, Friday, July 16 at 12:30 pm, we further celebrated Ken's life with Father Bihn saying the Holy Mass of Resurrection at St. Irenaeus. Ken's grandchildren participated in the mass by thoughtfully reading from Isaiah and St. Paul's letter to the Romans about God's promise of everlasting life to His children. Deacon Jerry read from John's Gospel about the same promises. Ken's family members presented gifts at the altar and led Intercessory Prayers.

Father Bihn drew from the wealth of biographical information about Ken provided by his family. Ken and Kay were childhood sweethearts from Norton, Kansas and married after high school. Ken enlisted in the Navy, and served in Naval Aviation in the Pacific and continued in the Naval Reserve, retiring as a Captain. He was deeply patriotic.

With over 59 years of marriage, Ken was deeply devoted to Kay, their four sons, and large extended family. He supported his family by a civilian aviation career and retired as an executive with Boeing.

Besides 50 years of service at St. Irenaeus in parish committees, funeral ministry, choir and Eucharistic ministry, Ken was a Fourth-Degree Knight and our council's Grand Knight for three years. Father Binh quipped that while serving funerals as a knight, Ken probably heard a lot of his eulogies! Ken continued in the Knights as a Trustee, that is mentor to younger knights. We were all touched by his hard work and willingness to do the most menial tasks. As Grand Knight Rick Tkach commented before presenting a bible to Kay and family, Ken lived "in spades" the four pillars of the Knights, namely Unity, Fraternity, Charity, and Patriotism.

Ken lived a life focused on his mission of doing good and living the Gospel. His death was sudden, but as Father Binh said, he was always prepared to meet his Lord.

Lessons I learned from Ken's life included smiling more at all with the joy that comes from love. He made me want to jump into any task as he did. The Saturday before he died on a Monday, Ken called me after volunteering at a St. Irenaeus community get together and promised to write a reflection on his good friend and brother knight Jim Chavez (RIP.) Maybe Ken was writing that story when he died sitting at his computer. Ken served to the moment of his death. Can we do any less? Keep on smiling!

Euthanasia by Organ Donation

The topic of euthanasia by organ donation is regularly being discussed at organ donation conferences. At each meeting, the conversation usually unexpectedly shifts to an emerging question of “death by donation” *in other words*, ending a person’s life with their informed consent by taking them to the operating room and under general anesthesia, opening their chest and abdomen surgically while they are still alive to remove vital organs for transplantation into other people.

This donation would bypass the long-honored dead donor rule, which forbids removal of vital organs until the donor is declared dead.

Under this scenario, people granted an assisted death would, with their full knowledge and consent, be transported to an operating room, put to sleep under general anesthesia and their organs removed, including the heart and lungs. Death would follow removal of the beating heart. Under so-called “euthanasia by organ donation,” the act of organ donation itself, not a lethal injection or a doctor-prescribed life-ending dose of barbiturates would be the mode of death.

Those in favor argue that eliminating the dead donor rule provides “benefits” by providing healthier organs for donation.

When physicians are participating in a procedure designed to take a person’s life, will patients feel 100% certain that their physician is firmly on the side of healing? What message does it send about the value of every human life when physicians endorse the exchange of one life for another?

The problem begins when society permits doctors, or others, to kill people. If euthanasia by organ donation becomes an accepted way to kill, then sadly, euthanasia will be promoted as a benefit to society creating another pressure to die.






