
Dear Brother Knights,

Dear Brother Knights,

During a Knights Exemplification, he hears the reading on Charity. This reading is summarized well by the last paragraph. "Charity moves the heart to comfort and console, advise and instruct, bear and forgive. In God and with God, we love even those we do not know. This is the charity that evangelizes. This is the charity that gladdens the heart"

The word Charity is derived from the Latin word, Caritas. The word Caritas means Love, as in God IS Love", Deus Caritas Est.

What does this love mean to being a Brother Knight? Caritas enables the heart to take an interest in your Brother Knights lives AND being vulnerable enough yourself to allow Brother Knights to care about what is going on with YOU. THE MYSTERIOUS MASS

On Thursday, July 13, 2023 Father Thinh Duc Pham spoke at St. Irenaeus Church on the topic "Why Do We Do That?" I didn't go to it but saw the recording of it on the St. Irenaeus U-Tube website later. Fr. Thinh's presentation stirred my mind and heart to a deeper understanding of the mass, but what did I learn about this amazing mystery?

He shared that he was a seminary classmate of our pastor, Father Binh Nguyen. Both men were born in Vietnam and escaped terrible Communist persecution there at a young age. Fr. Thinh studied the Liturgy for three semesters in Rome after his priestly ordination. For some time he has taught men studying for the priesthood about the liturgy.

My dictionary defined liturgy as "the rite of the Eucharist" and "the system of public worship in the Christian church." On July 13, St. Irenaeus had a 24 hour adoration of the Eucharist.

(I couldn't help remembering that on July 13, 1917, the Blessed Mother Mary appeared in Fatima, Portugal to three young shepherd children for the third time. Portugal was being targeted by Communists, who were taking over the whole country! Mary appeared for a sixth time on October 13, 1917. That appearance was witnessed by 70,000 people. Atheists and non-believers were among eye witnesses of the "Miracle of the Sun" that day. Portuguese secular newspapers covered the event with photographs and first-hand accounts. The Sun miraculously danced for ten minutes and looked as if it was going to strike the earth! That miracle turned Portugal from being led by atheist leaders to being a Christian country. Sorry for digressing.)

To get the full story of Fr. Thinh's powerful presentation, one must watch it on the St. Irenaeus website. He said the mass is the "Sacrament of Love." Vatican II was called in the 1960s by Pope St. John XXIII. The pope wanted to open the Catholic Church to look at itself in a mirror to address the modern world with Christianity's beautiful message.

Vatican II's first topic was its Constitution on the Liturgy. An instructor told Fr. Trinh that 50 years after it only 30% of its teachings have been realized. Before Vatican II the mass was passive. I remember that the priest had his back to the people, and the mass was in Latin. Vatican II sought not to "correct" the Church's behavior but to raise it to a higher level. Fr. Trinh described Vatican II's document on the Liturgy as a "Magna Carta" type proclamation.

Jesus said the first mass at the Last Supper, a Seder meal with his twelve chosen Apostles. In the garden that night He was arrested and later falsely accused by the Sanhedrin and sentenced to death by Pontius Pilate. According to St. John, who was at the Last Supper and was the only apostle who bravely stood at Jesus' Crucifixion, Jesus gave the apostles and all God's people His Body and Blood to eat and drink! In John Chapter 6, Jesus used graphic language to describe eating His flesh

and drinking His blood. Some stopped following Him, but He stood by His words! To this very day some 2,000 years later Fr. Trinh said, we are among the twelve apostles at each mass!

Each priest has been validly ordained in the line of the twelve apostles. We experience Jesus' Word in Sacred Scripture at mass proclaimed from the church ambo (pulpit.) On the altar, the priest remembers the Last Supper and the Holy Spirit changes the bread and wine into Jesus' Body and Blood. (Note: when Jews say "remember," at the Seder meal, they mean to bring to life!)

Fr. Trinh explained further that if we truly open our eyes, ears, and heart to the miracle of the Eucharist, we will be "amazed" as those around Jesus were at each of His miracles. He told us an elderly homebound recipient of Holy Communion was barely able to grasp the host from him with her gnarled hand. When he offered her communion on the tongue, she said, "Only when I suffer, Father, I understand the mystery of Eternal Life!" He kissed her hand and told her she helped him understand the Paschal Mystery!

Note: The early Christian writers, such as St. Irenaeus and St. Justin Martyr, all accepted Jesus' real presence in the Eucharist. All Catholics did too until the Protestant Reformation. There was never a Church council which questioned Jesus' real presence, according to Fr. Trinh! Jesus sacrificed Himself to save all people. The Eucharist has always been a sacrifice of Love offered to the Father! Jesus intended to unite all the People of God by His very presence in Word and the Eucharist.

From now on I will appreciate more deeply the mystery of each mass. I will ponder Fr. Trinh's burning question, "How can I connect my life into the Paschal Mystery (Jesus' Suffering, Death, and Resurrection)?"
