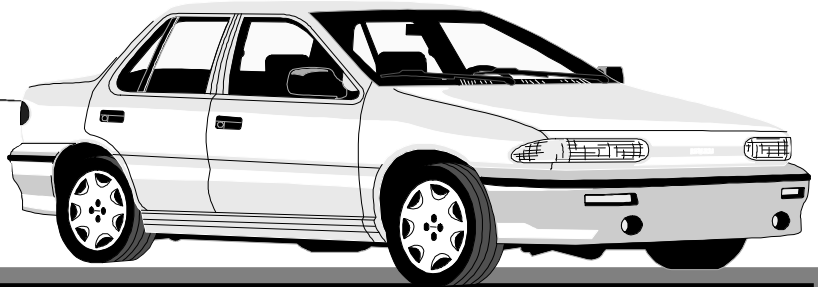
Now we can look forward to the Lenten season. If all of the Council comes together it will make our Fish Fry more successful as this will be our major fundraiser for the upcoming year.

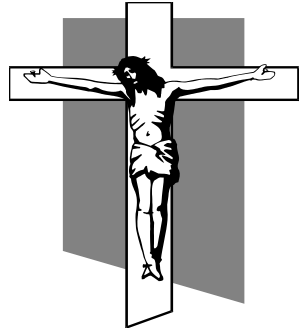

Unfortunately sometimes the real meaning of Christmas gets pushed aside on Christmas morning and lost in all of the gift wrap and bows.

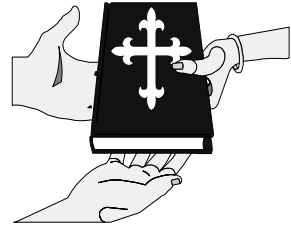

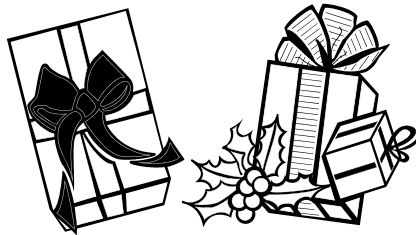
