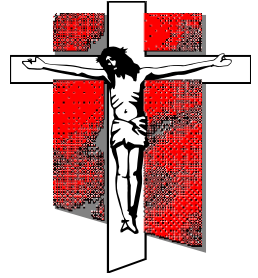

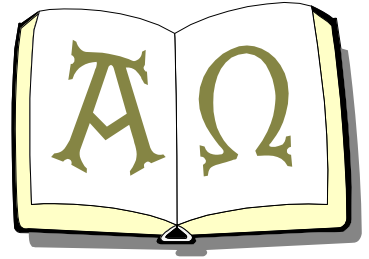

I hope everyone enjoyed the long weekend with family and good friends this last Thanksgiving.

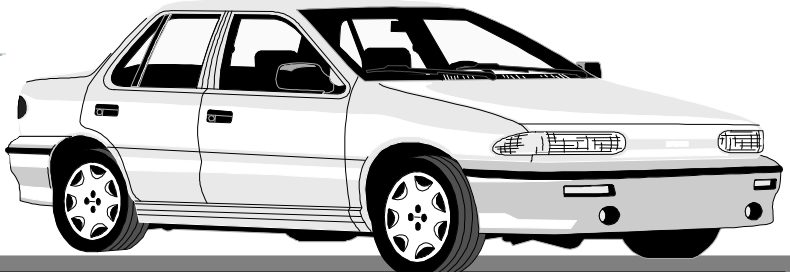
