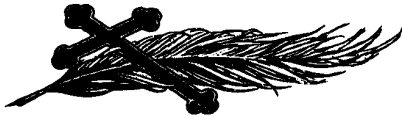

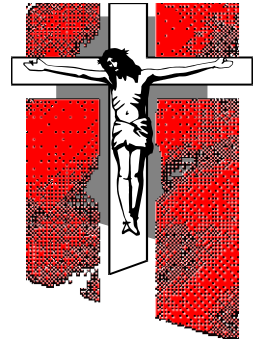

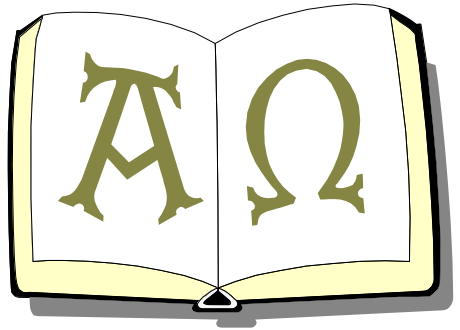
Our Father gave us His divine Son as a gift and through that “Gift” everyone who believes and receives His Son also receives eternal life.
