May God richly bless you and your family during this holy Advent and Christmas season.





# A Message from Your Council......Recorder & Respect Life, Justice & Peace Chairman



#### A VISIT FROM FATHER JOE

On Friday, October 30, 2020 at 10 AM, I was leaving St. Irenaeus Church after mass and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. It was a day before the Catholic Church was declaring Father Michael Joseph McGivney Blessed, the step before sainthood. It was a beautiful, cool day in Cypress, CA. A man I didn't know, who was wearing a black leather jacket and jeans, stopped me and asked, "Are you in the Knights of Columbus?" I said, "Yes," but I was puzzled. "How did you know?" I asked. He told me that he felt it in his heart. It was getting to be a strange exchange.

As we left church together, I noticed he had a silver rosary in his hand. Due to the Corona Virus, we both wore masks. He identified himself as Jovito Galaura and said he was a legal immigrant from the Philippines and had a work permit. He seemed eager to tell me something; so I listened. Jovito explained that a little over three months ago he contracted a severe case of Corona Virus and had to be hospitalized at the Adventist Hospital in Glendale, CA.

I asked him why he was in Cypress, CA at St. Irenaeus. He told me that he was living with his sister in Buena Park, and they were making a visit at the church. I was worried once he admitted having the deadly Corona Virus. Jovito went on to say that he had been in the Knights of Columbus in the Philippines, but he stopped practicing his faith at some point. He knew that Father McGivney had founded the Knights in October 1881 to protect immigrants by a fraternal society that insured its members. At that time there was an extreme prejudice in the USA against Catholics. Immigrant fathers were dying young and leaving their families destitute. Father McGivney, pastor of St. Mary's Church in New Haven, Connecticut, died at age 38 from pneumonia. He literally worked himself to death caring for his parishioners.

Jovito went on to tell me that his case of Corona Virus grew worse, to the point that he developed pneumonia. He was near death and began having dreams and delusions. With that information, I was really worried. Jovito said next that he didn't know if what happened in the hospital was a dream or reality. He distinctly saw a man dressed in white who entered his room and came to his bedside. The man identified himself as Father Joe. Father Joe heard Jovito's confession and gave him Holy Communion. After that, Jovito gradually recovered to the point where he could talk.

When he asked the hospital staff about who had come to see him, especially a Catholic priest named Father Joe, they flatly told him that Adventist hospitals never allow Catholic priests or outside clergy to visit patients. Jovito was astonished! After seventeen days in the hospital, he was released.

When he had recovered enough, Jovito travelled to New Haven, Connecticut to St. Mary's Church. He showed me a photograph of himself, wearing a mask. He was clearly placing his hand on Father McGiveney's black marble tomb, which rests inside the church. While in Connecticut, Jovito learned that Father McGivney was known as Father Joe when he went to visit parishioners on sick calls. Joseph was his middle name.

I had shivers listening to Jovito's story. As a federal asylum officer for ten years, I had interviewed applicants seeking political asylum from all over the world. I was trained to weed out true stories from false ones. Jovito spoke to me fluently in English and seemed sincere and credible.

My mind was racing with what to do next. I asked him if he would like to meet Father Aaron, our assistant pastor, who is from the Philippines, and he said, "Yes." I led Jovito through the church next door to the rectory. Father Aaron wasn't in, but Jovito left him a message with his name and number. Jovito seemed eager to tell Father Aaron his story, and he knew that if indeed he had been healed miraculously through Father Joe's intersession, the Catholic Church would have to investigate it thoroughly.

After leaving Jovito in the church to re-join his sister, I headed home and telephoned a nurse hotline from my insurance. Nurse Bobbie assured me after I gave her all the facts about my close encounter with a former Corona Virus sufferer that I was okay and didn't need a test for the virus. I was very relieved but had a lot of burning questions. Was it a miracle? Did Father Joe visit him and give him sacraments to return to his faith? Why did he stop me, a total stranger to him? Jovito claimed to have fully recovered from Corona Virus and said that he stopped testing positive for it. He did not ask me for anything except to hear his story. I believed his story and found it a strange coincidence that he told it to me the day before Father McGivney was declared Blessed. Thanks, Jovito, for your story, and thank you, Father McGivney, for founding the Knights, which now has two million members and has spread all over the world!
