Have a Blessed Christmas.

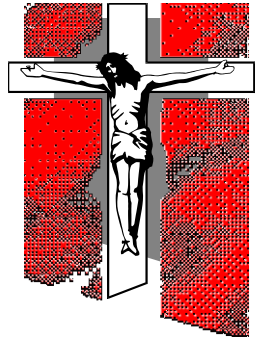

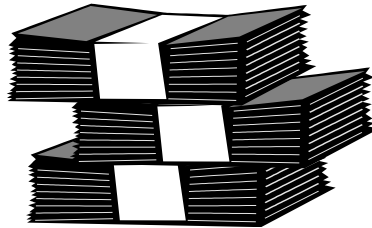

We have had mothers call us to inquire about getting married to their boyfriends because they want to do the right thing before their babies are born. We have had a mother who miscarried her baby at twenty weeks call us to ask about a proper burial for her baby.

Every time we get a phone call from one of our mothers about the sacraments, we reach out to the Catholic Church and connect them with our mothers. There's no doubt that our clients feel safe in asking our team and their mentors these questions about the sacraments, rather than randomly calling a church themselves to inquire.

We give thanks and praise to God because in the next few months, our Life Center will be moving to the same complex as our ultrasound provider, Prenatal Life Imaging. Wearing our servant aprons, our team will literally be able to shepherd our mothers over to their ultrasound appointments from our Life Center.

In *Walking With Moms*, our Life Center has great plans to continue building the Kingdom of God. Our new location will have an event space where we will be able to host Bible studies for our mothers and offer classes on love and responsibility, chastity, natural family planning, theology of the body, parenting and so much more. Unless our mothers know that their dignity comes from God and that He has a perfect plan for them and their bodies, they will continue to repeat the very behaviors that harm their souls and the souls of their children.

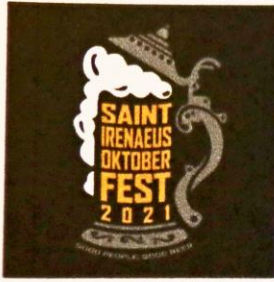

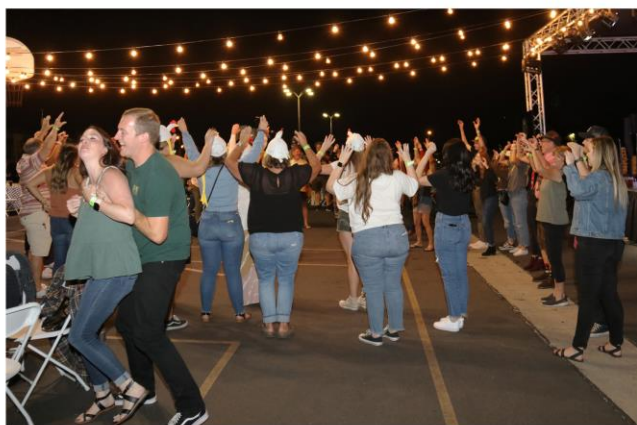
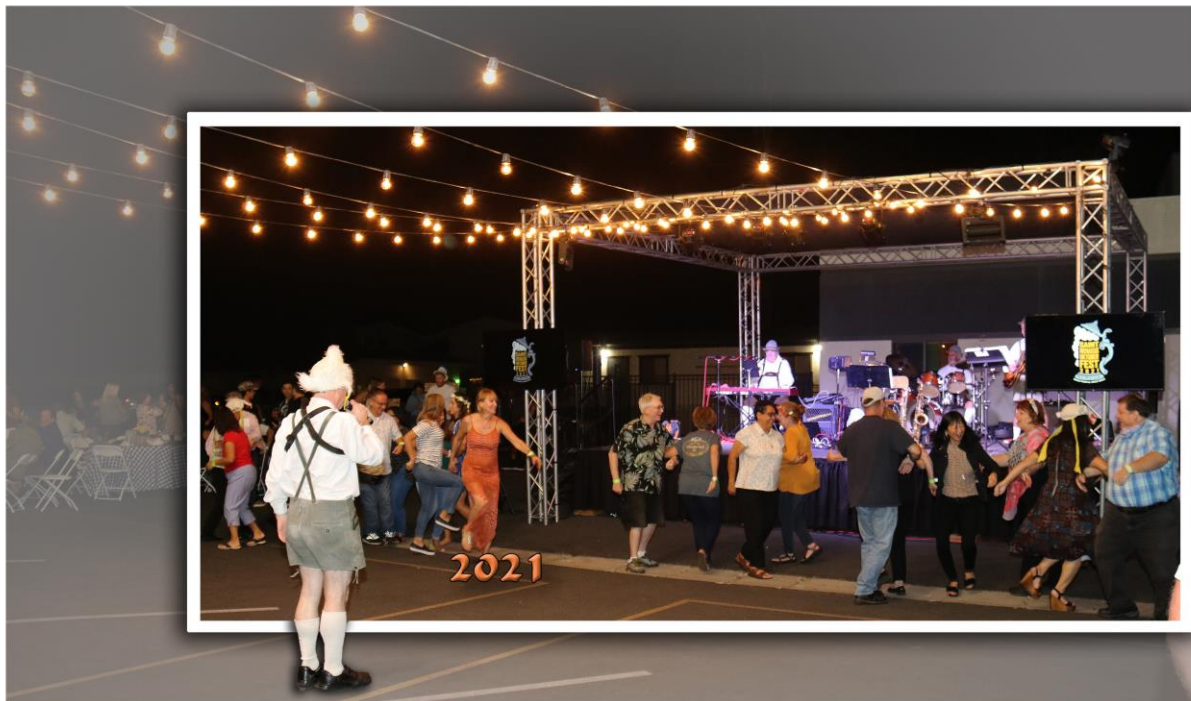
