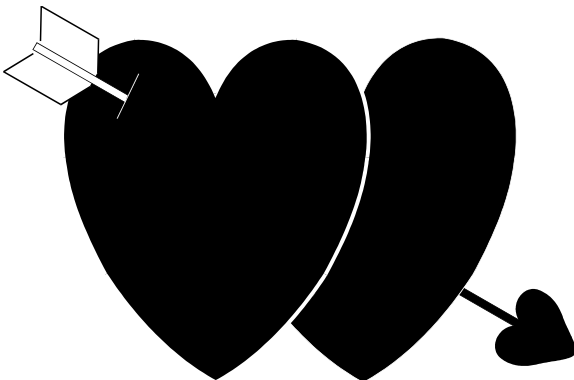
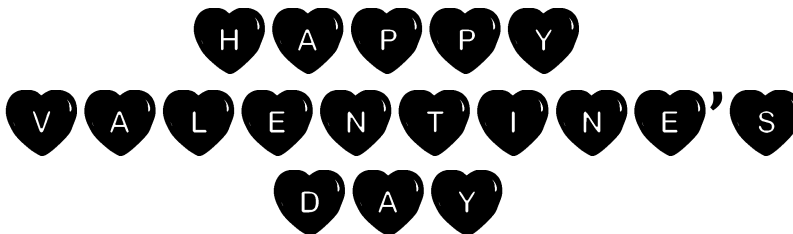

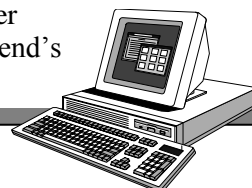

Brother Knights,

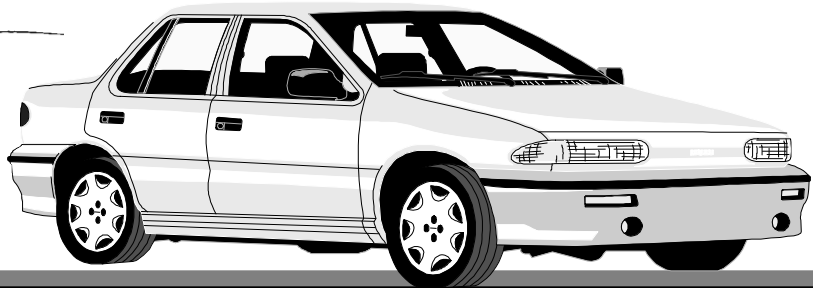

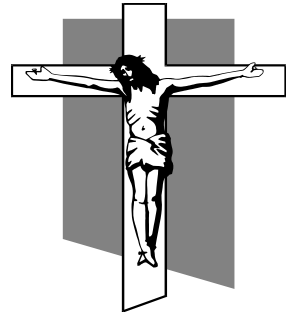

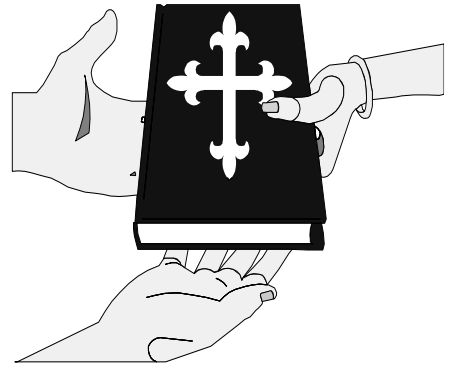

As you can see we have a very busy February, with the help and support of all our Brother Knights, this month will be a breeze.

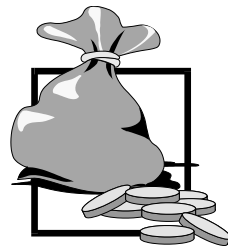

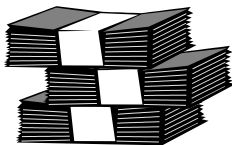

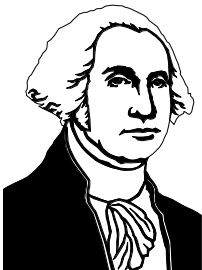

DEAD SEA: NOT FOR ME

Father Aaron of St. Irenaeus spoke to us in a recent homily about the "Dead Sea Analogy." He explained that the Jordan River in the Holy Land pours fresh water into the Dead Sea continuously. It stays there and goes nowhere. Thus the Dead Sea takes and takes but gives nothing. The analogy for us is that God constantly pours His graces into us. If we don't share that grace and love with others to spread the Light of Christ to the world, we are like the Dead Sea. If even one person sees the Light of Christ in us, we have done our job.

As we prepare for Lent (starts March 1), let us ask the Holy Spirit how God wants us to share. Brother Knight George E. Schulhoff developed the Novena to the Holy Spirit and started the Apostles of the Holy Spirit in Ohio while serving as the Chancellor of his local K of C council. Search "Apostles of the Holy Spirit" on the web (it is located in Cincinnati, Ohio) and print out the Novena to the Holy Spirit. You can also search its History. The Novena takes only a few minutes each day for 7 days. Several other knights and myself have been doing it for years. Brother Ray Richmond introduced it to me. The rewards and graces of the Novena are astounding! The sacraments and Sacred Scripture take on a whole new meaning. The Holy Spirit strengthens us (fortitude) and guides us (counsel, understanding, knowledge) and consoles us (piety, fear of the Lord) to finally reach wisdom. These are promises of the Holy Spirit, and believe me He delivers!

Whatever path you take during Lent, it is simply amazing the joy and happiness that come from the Holy Spirit! I pray that this month preparing for Lent is special for you and your families. God rewards our simple efforts to unite us with Him!
