





Thank you to all the brothers who have paid their annual dues from the emailed statement. You saved a lot of time and expense printing, folding, envelope stuffing, stamping, and mailing. If you are having difficulty paying your dues, please contact me or Rick Tkach, GK. Our phone numbers and email addresses are listed on page 2 of this bulletin. In concurrence with the precept of Charity from our 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, almost all our Council brothers have donated to our Council fund to assist covering dues for brothers who are having financial difficulty. We want to assist brothers in need to remain in good standing, so if you are in financial difficulty, please reach out.

Our Council now has 231 members, with 188 being regular members, 6 have "*Honorary*" status, and 37 have "*Honorary Life*" status. "*Honorary*" status is bestowed by Supreme Council on members who have at least 25 years of consecutive service and turn 65 years old. "*Honorary Life*" status is then achieved when an Honorary member turns 70.

Thank you, also, to those of you who returned your Fraternal Survey Forms, as the information contained in them is very important for Supreme to maintain our designation as an IRS recognized charity. This form has changed significantly from previous years due to the Faith in Action programs, which include activities specific to Faith, Family, Community, and Life.

Stay on the lookout for details about our Lenten Fish Fry's, which will be ***drive thru only***. Be sure to tell all your friends, as we need to have good turnouts.

MY FRIEND FRED

Fred Navarro of Buena Park, CA died on December 21, 2020 at age 85. Dolores, his wife, along with family stepped into their backyard that evening to witness the alignment of Saturn and Jupiter. She had goose bumps while staring at the bright light in the sky. Scientists say that when a star implodes it produces such a bright light. Was it the Christmas star? Fred was a star to hundreds, if not thousands. He stood just over five feet tall but had the heart of a giant! If you insert the letters “i” and “n” into his name, you get friend.

Sometime after joining St. Irenaeus Parish in 2000, I kept crossing paths with this balding, light-skinned, bespectacled Mexican American guy. He had such a warm smile and a twinkle in his eyes as he said, “Hello.” In 2007 I was at morning mass when the priest allowed us to pray intentions out loud. I struggled to name my parents, both of whom died later that year. After mass Fred quietly approached my pew and asked if he and friends could pray for my folks. That touched me deeply. As I got to know Fred, I learned how many souls he touched by his kind words, deeds, and prayers.

Fred had a challenging childhood, but he never lost hope. In fact, he worked for HOPE (Helping Ordinary People Everyday) at St. Irenaeus from its origins years ago. HOPE has helped thousands of needy of all faiths. The Presentation Sisters at St. Irenaeus have served the parish school since its founding without receiving any retirement. For many years Fred helped lead their annual fund raiser. He and Dolores always bought tickets to their St. Patrick show and dinner. Sister Rita (RIP) brought Fred into Eucharistic Ministry, allowing him to give communion at mass and to those who were homebound. Dolores assisted him in many of his works.

Fred brought me back to the Knights of Columbus, which I left at age nineteen after one year. I thought it was only older Catholic guys drinking beer. How wrong I was! He showed me the Knights are now over two million members strong and give billions of dollars and volunteer hours all over the world in wars, disasters, etc. He also introduced me to bible study, which I’ve loved since 2008. We learned so much and met so many wonderful folks in classes of thirty or more students. Fred always made sure we didn’t miss break time, a great time to sample the delicious goodies we took turns bringing to class.

For years Fred helped organize our yearly Men’s Retreat at Mater Dolorosa, Sierra Madre and made sure men without funds got to go. He was also very active in Cursillo (meaning short study), a spiritual group of men and women meeting once a week. When called on, Fred served at mass or funerals. He kept a worn-out notebook to keep track of the many people he promised to help. I can’t even imagine how many lonely or distraught folks he befriended and comforted!

Fred once told me, "I can't do a lot for folks, but I can love them." That is what he did best, for his wife and children and in-laws and grandchildren too. You might call him, "Jesus in disguise." His grandchildren called him, "Papa." He couldn't imagine being without Dolores or his family.

In the spring of 2008, Fred came a hair's breath away from death. He was rushed to Los Alamitos Medical Center with severe stomach pains. Doctors in emergency surgery removed some of his intestines. When I visited him in Intensive Care, his body was swollen, and he was hooked up to as many as seven tubes and devices for feeding and monitoring him. Dolores told me she made a pact with God that if He spared Fred, she would care for him and not complain. For the three months he was in ICU Fred's family never left his side. Dolores was the one who always said that Fred would be alright, and he was.

After long stretches in assisted living places, Fred came home. He continued to suffer in what I believe was his Purgatory. I believe Fred is a star in Heaven. Goodbye, dear friend Fred. We love you!



## Year of St. Joseph



Brother Knights,

On December 8, 2020, the Holy Father, Pope Francis, declared the "Year of St. Joseph." The Year of St. Joseph concludes on December 8, 2021. Pope Francis, in his Apostolic letter entitled *Patris Corde*, wrote: **"Joseph was the man chosen by God to guide the beginnings of the history of redemption."**

Joseph was the protector of Mary and Jesus and we share in that responsibility as Pope Francis tells us **"...they are also entrusted to our own responsibility, care and safekeeping."** Further: **"...Joseph continues to protect *the child and his mother*, and we too, by our love for the Church, continue to love *the child and his mother*."**

As Knights, we serve as the role of protector in our families and in our communities. According to Pope Francis: **"Fathers are not born, but made. A man does not become a father simply by bringing a child into the world, but by taking up the responsibility to care for that child. Whenever a man accepts responsibility for the life of another, in some way he becomes a father to that person."**

St. Irenaeus will be offering a special 33 day program beginning on **Monday, February 15th** and concluding on **Friday, March 19th** which is the *Feast of St. Joseph*. The program will include 6 meetings with 5 weekly meetings on Mondays starting on **February 15th** with the 6th meeting occurring on **Friday, March 19th** the *Feast of St. Joseph*. More details will be available in the church bulletin in the coming days as we prepare the final details for the program.

We will be following the book *Consecration to St. Joseph* created by Father Donald H. Calloway, who is a member of the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception. He has spoken at various events across the country including the *MAGNIFICAT* prayer breakfast in Anaheim, last February. Father Calloway's 33 day program is based upon the Litany of St. Joseph Prayer and provides a daily reflection, reading, and prayers which requires a 20 to 30 minute commitment each day. What a great way to develop or build upon our daily devotions to *God* and his Divine Providence especially during the Lenten Season!




