




What Greater Love

Dear Brother Knights,

Congratulations if you are one of the 14 Council members whose last name begins with the letter "**C**", as it's the only letter in the alphabet where all paid their 2021 Council dues !

The name drawn for the November "Good of the Order" drawing (meaning he was present at the meeting) was for \$20.00 was George O'Hara, who wasn't present. The name drawn for the December "Good of the Order" drawing for \$30.00 was Mike McGill, who wasn't present. The drawing at January meeting was \$40.00 that was won by Frank Faecke, congratulations Frank.

Dues Statements for 2022 calendar year have been sent out. In case you did not receive it, please call me. In addition to our \$32.00 dues, there are 3 special assessments included. *If you are having financial difficulties in paying your dues, please contact either myself or Grand Knight Rick Tkach as we can help you remain a Council Member in good standing.*

The 1st special assessment is for <u>Columbian Charities</u>, in the amount of only \$3.65. California Columbian Charities, Inc. is dedicated to assisting California Brothers in financial distress, including their widows. It has responded to over 2400 requests for assistance from Brother Knights in California and has given over \$3,600,000 in relief. Columbian Charities provides financial assistance to Knights of Columbus Brothers, with at least twelve months good standing in a California Council; and to their widows and orphans, by helping to relieve financial distress due to unemployment, sickness, family medical and hospital bills, overdue rent or mortgage payments, property tax, food, clothing, losses due to fire, flood or earthquake. All the financial assistance provided is a grant and need not be repaid. *If you know a Brother Knight who needs of assistance, contact our Grand Knight, who can obtain a Charity application from the California State Council office.* So please include the **\$3.65** added to your dues.

The 2nd is the Knights of Columbus <u>Culture of Life Fund</u>, is a permanent fund established by a vote of the delegates to the 2008 Supreme Convention in Quebec City. As of December 2016, the initiative has funded and placed 829 ultrasound machines, valued at more than \$40 million, in all 50 states, as well as in Canada, Jamaica, Guatemala and Peru, and helped save the lives of thousands of babies. So please include the **\$2.00** added to your dues.

<u>The 3rd is Council Brothers in Financial Difficulty</u>, which is a Council fund established last year following the founding Principle of our Order, Charity, to assist Council Brothers in financial difficulty in keeping their dues current. So please include the **\$5.00** added to your dues.





A Message from Your Council......**Recorder** Faith Director & Vehicle Donation Chairman

ISAIAH By FRANK FAECKE



The Dead Sea Scrolls, known as the Qumran Scrolls, are ancient Jewish and Hebrew religious manuscripts first found in 1947 by a shepherd boy at the Qumran Caves. The scrolls themselves were written between the 3rd and 1st centuries B.C. The most complete document among the scrolls was the Book of Isaiah. After the 66 chapters were translated, they were found to be almost word for word the same as the church has used for thousands of years. The book was written by the prophet Isaiah and the school he inspired from the eighth to the sixth centuries B.C.

Dear prophet Isaiah look from Heaven at what your words (inspired by the Holy Spirit) have said and done. Masses and church services all over the world have spread your words to the ears of the People of God everywhere. I found a few passages of Isaiah (abbreviated Is) from masses in the book *Give Us This Day* as follows:

On December 1 we heard, "On this mountain the Lord of hosts will provide for all peoples a feast of rich food and choice wines, juicy, rich food and pure, choice wines. On this mountain he will destroy the veil that veils all peoples, the web that is woven over all nations; he will destroy death forever." (Is 25) Wow, what a promise!

On December 2 you spoke, "Trust in the Lord forever! For the Lord is an eternal Rock." (Is 26) On December 3 you said, "When his children see the work of my hands in his midst, they shall keep my name holy; they shall reverence the Holy One of Jacob, and be in awe of the God of Israel." (Is 29) On December 4 you told us, "Thus says the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel: O people of Zion, who dwell in Jerusalem, no more will you weep; He will be gracious to you when you cry out, as soon as he hears he will answer you.." (Is 30) What promises!

We began mass on Sunday, December 5, with words as follows: "O people of Zion, behold the Lord will come to save the nations, and the Lord will make the glory of his voice heard in the joy of your heart." (Is 30) On December 6 (Memorial of St. Nicholas), you told us, "The desert and the parched land will exult; the steppe will rejoice and bloom. They will bloom with abundant flowers, and rejoice with joyful song." (Is 35)

On Sunday, December 12, we heard, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor." (Is 61) On Sunday, December 19, you tell us, "Behold a Virgin shall conceive and bear a son; and his name will be called Emmanuel." (Is 7) Finally at Midnight mass in the wee hours of December 25, we listen as you say, "The people who walked in

darkness have seen a great light; upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom, a light has shone. You have brought them abundant joy and great rejoicing....For a child is born to us, a son is given to us; upon his shoulder dominion rests. They name him Wonder-Counsellor, God-Hero, Father-Forever, Prince of Peace...." (Is 9)

We thank you and all in Heaven and throughout the Earth in sharing the joy and fulfilment of your words uttered so long ago as realized in Jesus' birth. Merry Christmas! Blessed New Year everyone!


