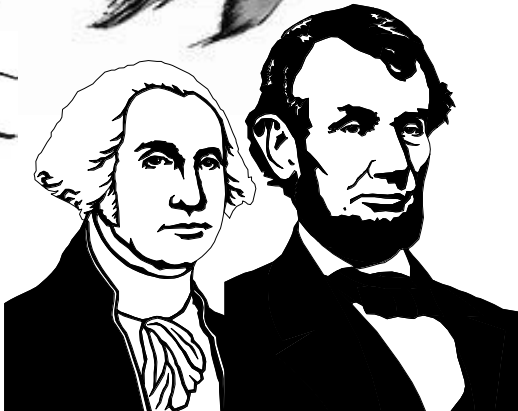

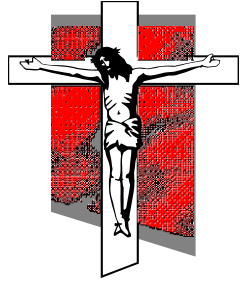

*Psalm 103: 10-14: **He does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him for he knows how we are formed.***

*Psalm 130: 3-4 If you O Lord, kept a record of sins, who could stand? But with you there is forgiveness.*

*Isaiah: 43:18-19 **forget the former things; do not dwell on the past** 43: 24-25 but you worry me with your sins and your offenses. **I am He who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more.***

*Isaiah 44: 22 **I have swept away your offences like a cloud, your sins like the morning mist. Return to me, for I have redeemed you.***

*John 8: 34-35-36 Jesus replied, “I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin. Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever. **So if the “Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.”***

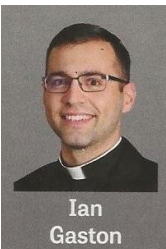


Dear Brothers Knights,

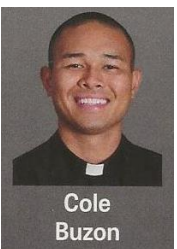

## **FINANCIAL SECRETARY**



Dear Brother Knights,

The drawing winner for early dues payment went to Brother **Louis Bloch**. Dennis J Montoya name was drawn for Good of the Order, but unfortunately, he was not present. Next month's drawing will be for **\$50.00**.

Thank you to all the brothers who have paid their annual dues from the emailed statement. You saved a lot of time and expense printing, folding, envelope stuffing, stamping, and mailing.

Our Council now has 156 members, with 110 being regular members, 3 have "*Honorary*" status, and 43 have "*Honorary Life*" status. "*Honorary*" status is bestowed by Supreme Council on members who have at least 25 years of consecutive service and turn 65 years old. "*Honorary Life*" status is then achieved when an Honorary member turns 70.

The Special Assessments included with this year's dues included:

- \$2.00 for Culture of Life, which supports activities at Supreme for protection of the unborn.
- \$3.65, which is a State Council fund assisting brother Knights in financial need
- \$5.00 to assist brother Knights in our Council who have financial hardship for dues payment
- \$10.00 for Ukraine Relief Fund. All funds collected go to Supreme for refugee assistance.

Thank you, also, to those of you who returned your Fraternal Survey Forms, as the information contained in them is very important for Supreme to maintain our designation as an IRS recognized charity. This form has changed significantly from previous years due to the Faith in Action programs, which include activities specific to Faith, Family, Community, and Life.

Stay on the lookout for details about our Lenten Fish Frys, which will begin **February 24**. Our diners are looking forward to the fellowship of indoor dining once again. Be sure to tell all your friends, as we need to have good turnouts.

I hope to see all of you at our Business Meeting on February 28<sup>th</sup>.

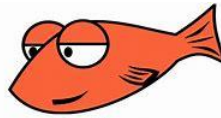

## Message from Your Council.....Recorder



My Brothers,

Christmas and New Year's was so hectic and personal issues are creeping up and not resolving. By the time January 13th came around, I was a wreck.

Exhausted and tired, I made it to Adoration in January and sat with our Lord for an hour. This was the first time that I had been to Adoration in many months. Gazing upon the Eucharist, telling the Lord all of my sorrows, all of my worries, helps to calm my body and mind. Sometimes at Adoration, I will weep and then after weeping, doze off in the comfort of our Lord. Adoration really should not be one of the Catholic Church's most keep secrets for our busy and hectic lives. Everyone should know about the grace of sitting with our Lord in Adoration.

If people knew the power of sitting in the presence of our Lord in the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the church would be packed full of people seeking our Lord. Whenever the storms of life are getting too great to handle, Christ is there in the Eucharist to remind us of the grace and mercy of God. Christ reminds us that he is in our little boat. Like the Apostles who were frightened by the storm while Jesus slept, Jesus will either calm the storm or guide us through it. I would prefer that Jesus always calm the storm, but that isn't usually the case. More often than not, he brings me through it.

I do my very best to trust in God. I know that he is faithful even when I am not faithful. But I usually find that I have my "Plan B" in my back pocket just in case God is taking his time with my request. When I don't get what I want, I start executing my plan. And that is when I find myself most uneasy; when my will and God's will do not align. I might as well be walking down the road of life with one shoe on and one shoe off.

When I re-align my will to God's Will, I am more at peace. Life may or may not be getting any easier, but my perspective on it changes.

I am certain that I am not alone in experiencing these emotions. This is where I cherish being part of a Fraternal order. I have brothers who believe in Christ and the Real Presence of the Eucharist who will pray for me, support me and help me succeed. I in turn am able to pray for my Brothers and to build them up. This Council is a gift of God's love to us. Let us continue to pray for one another and build one another up and encourage each other in Christ.

There for forty long days and nights, He purified Himself by constant fasting and praying to His Father. He was ready to meet and defeat the evil one, the Devil. Lent, a name which comes from the Middle English word “Lente or Lenten,” which originally meant “spring,” became our Christian way of following Him. Spring is the time of the year when the dead of winter gives way to new life.

Just as the most dedicated in all walks of life, we Christians from the very beginning through the present seek to purify ourselves to celebrate the greatest feast of the year, Easter! The Church tells us to follow the Old Testament disciplines of fasting, praying, and almsgiving to God and our neighbor.

Our ultimate reward is Eternal Life with our Creator and all of our loved ones who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith. For me the greatest humans who have walked the face of the Earth are not necessarily the most famous or well known. They are those humble souls who have been purified before being united with pure love, which we call God! However, since we are all sinners, let’s come to Jesus as we are! I wish everyone a blessed Lent and Easter!

# Pro-Life Information .....



Brothers Knights,

Happy February. In a few short weeks we will once again enter the liturgical season of Lent. With that in mind, I have two things for you to consider in the upcoming weeks as you prepare for Lent:

1. Offer a weekly day of fasting for the unborn in addition to Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The holocaust of abortion continues to ripple through our country and even seems to be accelerating in some states in the post Roe era. Abortion or infanticide/homicide is one of the sins that cry out to the Lord in vengeance and we must engage in reparation to atone for the sins of our country. Now back to fasting. By fasting I don't necessarily mean food, but I mean fasting from something that is pleasurable that would cause you to suffer to unite yourself with Christ. For example, if you golf on Fridays, perhaps you skip it for seven Fridays. For myself, food is a cross so I strive to at least refrain from food for the first six hours of my day but go longer if I can. Although prayerful meditation should be our first line of defense when we get close to falling, I would be withholding information from you if I didn't say that a hot cup of tea does wonders too! Did you know that you can practice fasting or abstinence outside of Lent as well? Many Catholics still use Fridays as a day to offer a sacrifice to the Lord since this was the day of the week when he entered into his Passion.
2. Consecrate yourself to Saint Joseph on March 19th. Even if you joined us during 2021, you can always reaffirm your consecration. 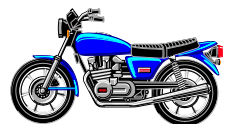
