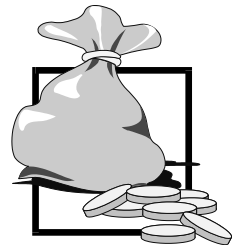
### **St. Irenaeus Evangelization Retreat January 22, 23 & 24, 2016 Adoration**

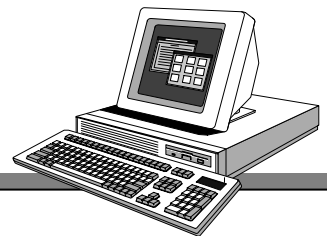
