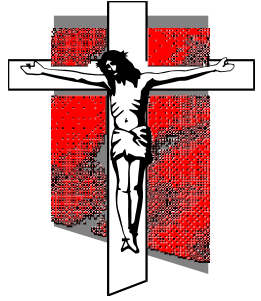

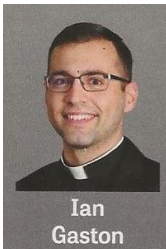
Dear Brothers Knights,

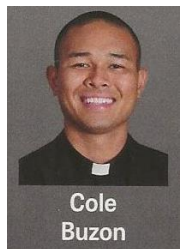

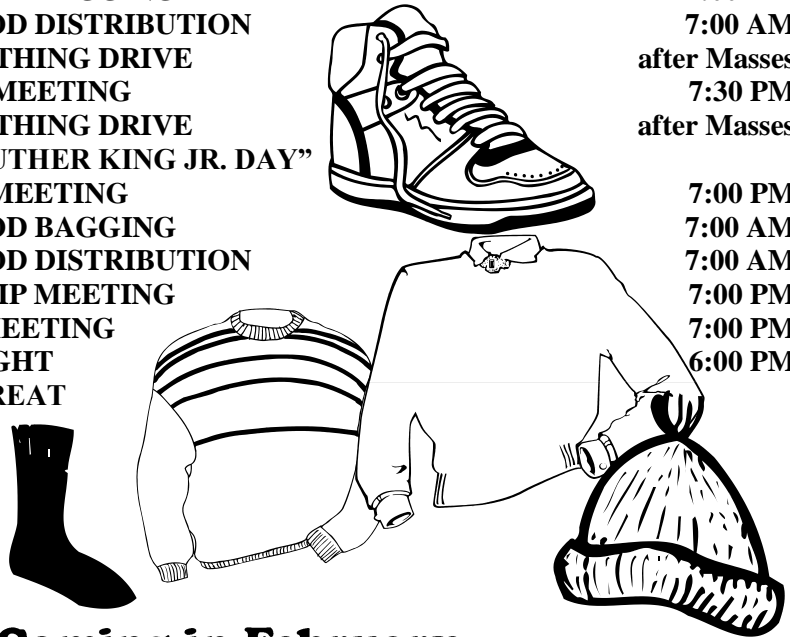

My Dear Brothers,

Happy New Year! For the first full year back from the Pause; as Covid is starting to be called; Our Council did some great work. We embark again on our own "Liturgical" calendar of sorts. We will be helping with the Warm Clothing drive, the Free-throw Contest, March for Life, Mother's Day Flowers and brunch, Veterans Wheel chair event, Parish festival and more.

What another rich month of feasts is January! January is full of Saints who went through Conversion or gave up luxury for service. One of my favorite Saints is Saint Francis de Sales, whose feast Day is on January 24. As a person who suffers from anxiety and self-doubt, I have leaned on a quote from Saint Francis de Sales since I first learned about him at a St. Irenaeus Parish Mission.

"Have patience with all things, but chiefly have patience with yourself. Do not lose courage in considering your own imperfections but instantly set about remedying them - every day begin the task anew".

Every day....begin the task anew. That is our goal for this new year and for each day in it. We may do very little perfectly. We might be worried of saying yes for fear of failure or embarrassment. We might let the doubt about our imperfections be a door that the evil one uses to keep us from fully living our faith. We might allow that discouragement to keep us from fully engaging, shaking off setbacks, seeking reconciliation and trying again.

The day after St. Francis de Sales Feast Day is the Conversion of St. Paul on January 25th! Did you know that he was the chief Christian persecutor before his conversion? Did you know he spent 3 years in preparation before being accepted by St. Peter? Did you know that his entire life after his Conversion he felt inadequate and unqualified for the mission that Jesus gave to him? Oh what role models we have when we feel unqualified for what Christ has called us to do! God qualifies us for the mission he has given us! Our responsibility is to surrender and allow God's Will to be done.

Let's pour ourselves into our work this year. Let's invite more men to join us. Let us grow each other's faith. Let's be the eyes and hands and feet of Christ and if we stumble or we get set back we simply begin the task anew, with Christ to guide us.

OUR JOURNEY TO GLORY

A modern Ultrasound machine was created to show our tiny forms taking shape, growing, and developing. At the miracle of our birth we were brought out into the light of life!

Jesus as the second person of the Holy Trinity was present for all eternity. In time He humbled Himself to be conceived as a human inside the womb of Mary. After nine months, He was born in the humble surroundings of a stable at Bethlehem. Miracles abounded around His birth! Angels sent poor shepherds to behold His light in the manger! Wise men from the East journeyed afar following a star to Bethlehem, where they presented gifts to this child.

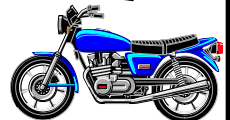
