I hope everyone had a great time at the Fiesta. And to all that worked the Sausage Booth for us, thank you for a job well done. Next year's Fiesta should be just as good.

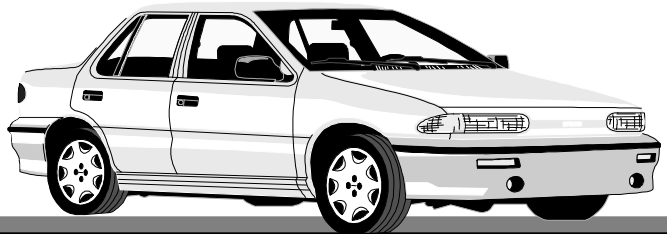
I look forward to seeing all of you at the pancake breakfast's this year, and the September Blood drive. Neither can be a success without your help.

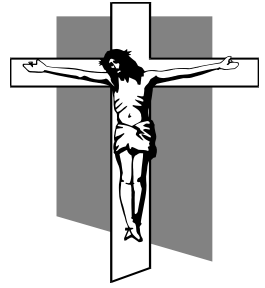

COUNCIL CHAPLAIN'S CORNER



The Price of Freedom

Richard Stockton was a prominent lawyer and a wealthy landowner. He was born in Britain October 1, 1730. Few Americans remember who he was or about the high price he paid for our freedom. He was sent to America by the British government and became very involved in the war effort and also was one of the men who signed our Declaration of Independence.

He came home from a fact-finding mission only to find that his hometown in New Jersey had been overrun by the British. He managed to get his family out just in time but he was captured and thrown into prison. They offered him amnesty if he would swear allegiance to the King, he refused and spent several years under horrible conditions. Lack of food and freezing conditions left him in poor health. When he finally was released he had lost everything. His home, his extensive library, his writings and all of his property. He died a pauper at age fifty-one.

This was a man who gave up everything because he believed in our freedom and he has sadly over time been all but forgotten. He was only one of many.

Before he died Richard Stockton wrote a statement of faith, which read “As my children..may be peculiarly impressed with the last words of their father, I think proper here, not only to subscribe to the entire belief of the great leading doctrine of the Christian religion...but also in the heart of a fathers affection, exhort them to remember that the fear of the Lord is the beginning of Wisdom.”

When the members of the U.S.S. Continental Congress approved of our Declaration of Independence they knew that what they were proposing would only work in a society where our Creator would be acknowledged. They affirmed that God has “endowed all people with the right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness, because he values each and every one of us. Our nation must remain “One Nation under God.” We must continue to be a God fearing Nation. True freedom is not having our own way, but yielding to Gods way.

As we celebrate our nation this July 4th let's keep in mind *Galatians 5:11* “*stand steadfast in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.*” Please remember all those who have paid the price for our freedom.

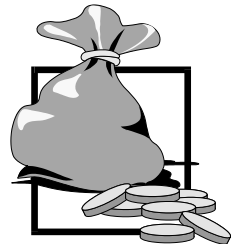

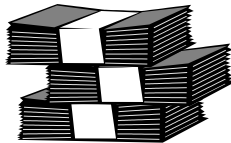

PRO-LIFE Notes • • • • •



Dear Brother Knights,

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are endowed by their creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness---that to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among men.

The Supreme Court is part of that Government our founding fathers instituted to secure these rights. A couple of weeks ago I was told abortion is a constitutional right and to have an abortion is a right (Roe v Wade). There was a time when slavery was a constitutional right and to own a slave was a right (Dred Scott Decision).

When future generations look back on American history will they find the darkest day to be January 22, 1973. The day the Supreme Court did not secure the right to life for the unborn and in fact removed protections to secure their lives. As a result over 55 million people have died. The Supreme Court did not protect them. The Supreme Court did in fact remove protection for the unborn in all fifty states. In short they failed to uphold the Constitution. No group men and woman has less respected for the Constitution than the Supreme Court. They failed to speak for those who couldn't speak. In fact they cause a great injustice. An injustice that takes place every day and with every single abortion.

Every single abortion also marks a failure. A failure to put an end to this injustice. What does this say about us as nation? What does this say when we vote for the men who sustain this injustice? How much longer will this loss of life go on? A better question might be, what will gods judgment be to this injustice? Abraham Lincoln once questioned if the Civil War was God's just judgment for the sin of Slavery. A war in which 600,000 to 800,000 thousands lives were lost.
