

# COUNCIL CHAPLAIN'S CORNER



#### The Price of Freedom

Richard Stockton was a prominent lawyer and a wealthy landowner. He was born in Britain October1, 1730. Few Americans remember who he was or about the high price he paid for our freedom. He was sent to America by the British government and became very involved in the war effort and also was one of the men who signed our Declaration of Independence.

He came home from a fact-finding mission only to find that his hometown in New Jersey had been overrun by the British. He managed to get his family out just in time but he was captured and thrown into prison. They offered him amnesty if he would swear allegiance to the King, he refused and spent several years under horrible conditions. Lack of food and freezing conditions left him in poor health. When he finally was released he had lost everything. His home, his extensive library, his writings and all of his property. He died a pauper at age fifty-one.

This was a man who gave up everything because he believed in our freedom and he has sadly over time been all but forgotten. He was only one of many.

Before he died Richard Stockton wrote a statement of faith, which read "As my children..may be peculiarly impressed with the last words of their father, I think proper here, not only to subscribe to the entire belief of the great leading doctrine of the Christian religion...but also in the heart of a fathers affection, exhort them to remember that the fear of the Lord is the beginning of Wisdom"

When the members of the U.S.S. Continental Congress approved of our Declaration of Independence they knew that what they were proposing would only work in a society where our Creator would be acknowledged. They affirmed that God has "endowed all people with the right to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness, because he values each and every one of us. Our nation must remain "One Nation under God." We must continue to be a God fearing Nation. True freedom is not having our own way, but yielding to Gods way.

As we celebrate our nation this July 4<sup>th</sup> let's keep in mind *Galatians 5:11* "stand steadfast in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage." Please remember all those who have paid the price for our freedom.




Greetings gentlemen,


