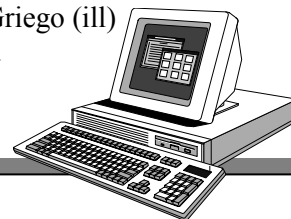

As we start our New Fraternal Year, pray that the Holy Spirit will sprinkle us with abundant blessing and a successful fraternal year.

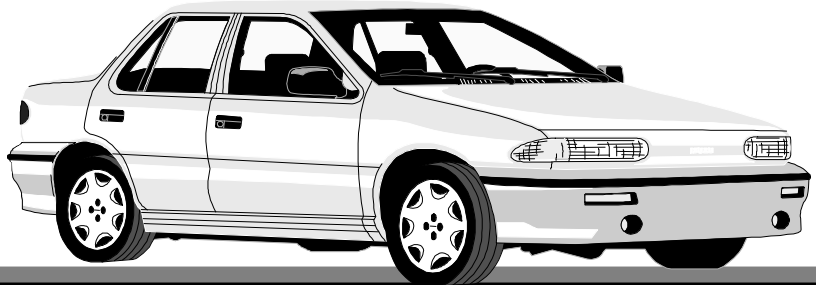
