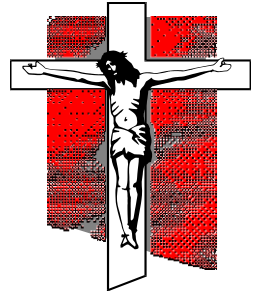

Message from Your Council.....Recorder



Dear Brothers,

I came into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil on April 7, 2012 I participated on and off at Mass for 20 years with my wife who is a cradle Catholic before becoming a Catholic. I remember the day that God spoke to my heart about becoming Catholic. It was Superbowl Sunday 2010. I was running Donut Duty for the Scouts and since it was Superbowl, I had agreed to handle the 11 AM Mass and walk across the street to a friend's house after Mass.

The Gospel that day was the Parable of the Sheep and the Goats (Matthew 25:31-46) where Jesus says "And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers you did it to me.'"

I met two strangers that day, a young man who came by the church every weekend and usually didn't speak to me. He talked to me about the church, he looked so different to me that day than he normally did. Then an elderly woman came and sat with me and told me of her devotion to Mary. She encouraged me to pray contemplatively.

During all this time, God is speaking to my heart prompting me to become a Catholic so that I could receive the Eucharist. It was clear that this was not a call that I was to ignore. I began RCIA in August that summer. This call to become Catholic quietly waited until the fall. In October 2011 my heart caught fire for Christ and remained white hot for over a year.

Receiving the Eucharist for the very first time as an adult was such an emotion filled experience. I had come to truly believe that the Eucharist IS the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ! and I was being allowed to receive! I ate the Host as a hungry man but then sat and experienced the taste and smell of the Eucharist lingering on my tongue and I gave thanks to God for calling me to the table.

I recalled St. Augustine's beautiful words of conversion. "You called and cried out loud and shattered my deafness. You were radiant and resplendent, you put to flight my blindness. You were fragrant, and I drew in my breath and now pant after you. I tasted you, and I feel but hunger and thirst for you. You touched me, and I am set on fire to attain the peace which is yours."

This June the Knights have been asked to participate in the Parish events to shed light on the Eucharist being the Real Presence. May we light one soul on fire, open one heart to return to Christ or call one soul to join the Catholic Church. May we stir up our own flame into a white hot flame and let our love for Christ shine through us.

On May 25, 2023, many of us celebrated Louie Chavez, who died recently at age 90. Father Binh in his eulogy/homily described Louie's full life, and others told me stories of how Louie helped so many.

Louie and Theresa attended the same high school in Los Angeles, California, but it was when he saw this "Pretty Woman" Theresa walking down the street with her mom that he started a conversation with Theresa that never ended. The rest was history that led to their marriage and many years together.

Louie served in the U.S. Navy. Later he worked for the sheriff's office and did undercover work to nail businesses that granted smog check certificates fraudulently.

Louie was a skilled carpenter who built the beautiful wooden lectern and presider's chair at Saint Irenaeus, as well as tables, the huge wooden procession cross used on Good Friday, and manger scenes for Lent. Mary Jo said Louie even climbed a tall ladder in the sacristy to get figures out of storage for Lent until she stopped him. He worked until she was finished with her beautiful altar decorations!

Louie helped H.O.P.E., and Theresa was the Saint Irenaeus School secretary. Louie was a loyal 4th Degree Knight. He ran casino trips to raise funds for charity. He loved and supported our Presentation Sisters, and several of them who were able celebrated his life at the funeral.

Brother Bobby Velasquez presented Louie's son and daughter a bible that many of us knights signed and a chalice engraved with his name. Some priest will celebrate mass with that chalice after it is blessed and pray for Louie and his loved ones at the greatest prayer on Earth, the mass!

Yes, Louie and Theresa received many other accolades. He suffered greatly with the suffering of Theresa and her sister, but now he and they are at peace. I apologize for omitting any of the great stories about Louie. Without a doubt, he was well-liked by many, maybe even some of those he apprehended in law enforcement!

We continue our heart-felt prayers for Louie and Theresa and family and all our fallen knights and their dear ones!
