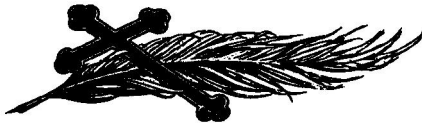

Dear Brother Knights,

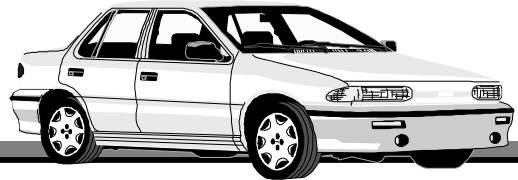

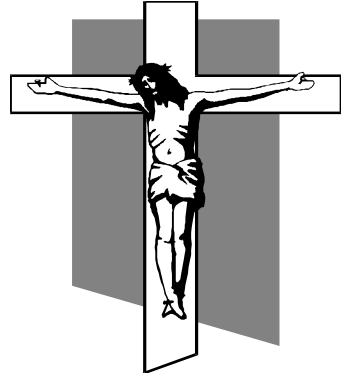

In my universe you’re my bright shining star.

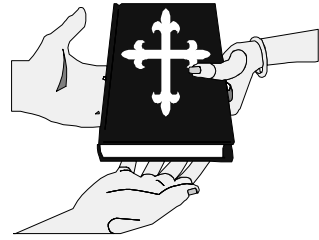
