A Message From Your Council.....Recorder & Respect Life, Justice & Peace Chairman

Marriage



On June 26, 2015 the U.S. Supreme Court declared same sex "marriage" a legal marriage. According to Trent Horn, Catholic Apologist, marriage is what comprehensively and completely unites men and women to one another and to any children they might procreate. Please bear with me as we reflect on words of Horn from a CD from Lighthouse Catholic Media entitled "HOW TO TALK ABOUT Same Sex Marriage." Brother Ken Peterson PGK and his wife Kay shared this CD with me. The Church says a same sex union could never be a marriage in the first place, according to Horn. He says marriage is a conjugal union, not a relational union.

The five essential elements to marriage are best explained in the conjugal view of marriage. First, civil marriage is an official registered government union. Second, marriage is ideally a lifelong union. Third, marriage is a union between two people. Fourth, marriage is a sexual union. Fifth, marriage is an exclusive union.

The conjugal view is that there is no other relationship like it, because a man and a woman completely give themselves to one another in mind and body. The two incomplete on their own become one flesh ordered toward the common good that the government has an interest in. That good is procreation, which produces its future citizens.

The relational view cannot explain why marriage is between only two people. Why not add more people to the marriage in a relational view? The more the merrier. The conjugal view says that marriage is the complete union of man and woman in one flesh, ordered toward the good of procreation.

The conjugal view says sex belongs in marriage. The marriage certificate states that the two become one, which is solidified in the conjugal union of husband and wife.

The conjugal view says marriage is an exclusive union in which men and women comprehensively unite. You can't comprehensively unite with someone if you have someone else on the side. Dan Savage, a sex advice columnist stated in a New York Times interview that he had double digit others on the side besides his partner. When pressed and in the presence of his partner, he said it was only 9 others with whom he had had sexual relations on the side.

What are your eyes showing you? Do you believe your own eyes?

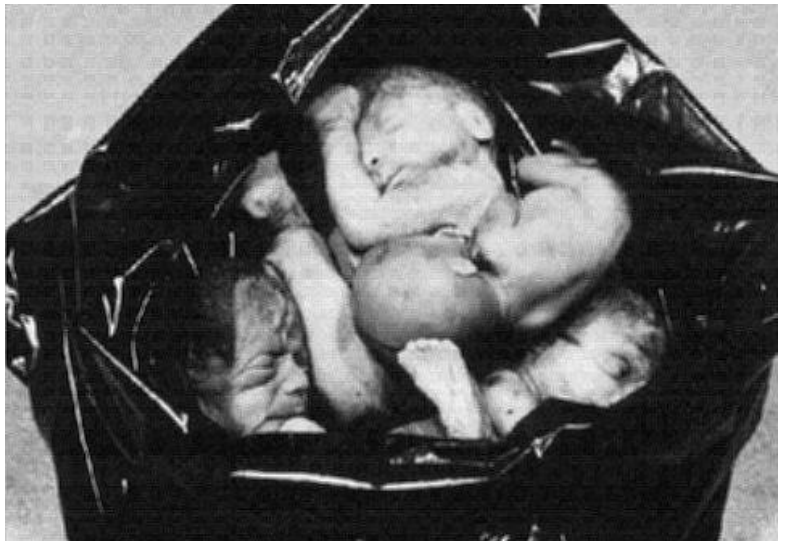

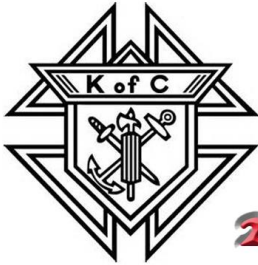
