TWO HEARTS BEATING AS ONE

When you shook his hand, you marveled at its size. Some called him Bill; I called him Dad. His heart was as big as his hands. He did a lot but never bragged.

A lifetime Catholic, he married outside the Church. He gave up Holy Communion but never missed Sunday mass. Mom (Elsie) grew up Baptist, reared by good Christian parents. When I was a seminarian, she took instructions and became Catholic. She had her wartime marriage annulled and married Dad in the Church.

Mom and Dad retired in rural New Mexico, where Dad built an A-frame home. He used his God-given talents as a carpenter, artist, and cook. His best watercolor was of Mother Teresa. Mom and Dad both helped strangers whose vehicles broke down on many occasions.

I did not become a priest but never lost my love for the Church. How can I forget Dad's care for Mom her last 7 years as she progressed in dementia? He hardly left her side. Two months after he celebrated his 90th birthday, he died from a massive heart attack, worn out caring for Mom. Mom had a "Jacob's Ladder" vision in a dream, stairs leading to Heaven. She then no longer feared death. Three months after Dad she passed.

We saw God's grace and love in their lives. They took care of their parents until they died. They bore heartaches from all their children's choices but never ceased to love them. 60 years together in life. United forever in Heaven!
