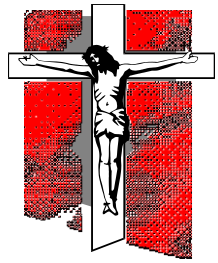

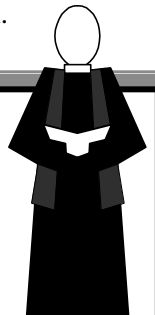
A father is someone you look up to no matter how tall you grow and some of the best fathers are not the ones who gave you life but the ones who teach you how to live it.

Dear Brother Knights,

I hope this letter finds you all healthy and in good spirits, and hopeful as the loosening of restrictions on live gatherings continues to evolve.

The name pulled for “Good of the Order” drawing at our May meeting for \$110.00 was Joseph Le, who was not present. The June drawing will now be for \$120.00.

Our election of Officers for the 2020-2021 Columbian Year will be held during our June Business Meeting, **which will be held live in our Parish Hall** and will also be online on Zoom. Be sure to attend and make your vote and voice heard.

UNITY IN DIVERSITY

On Sunday, May 23, 2021, I stepped onto the Cypress College re-cycled track. As I rounded the track, I ruminated on recent readings and reflections. It was Pentecost Sunday, the birthday of the Church.

One commentary told me that this day, celebrated fifty days after Christ's resurrection, had a parallel in the Jewish feast of Succoth (Booths.) Succoth celebrated the time when Yahweh (God) gathered Israel at Mt. Sinai to unite them as a nation under the law. It has been celebrated fifty days after Passover.

Shortly into my walk, I felt the cool breeze across my face as I spotted our American flag gently wafting in the slight wind. Our country was founded as an experiment of unity in diversity. Bishop Robert Barron in his online sermon for the day reflected on Paul Tillich, according to Wikipedia a German-American philosopher and Lutheran theologian/minister. Tillich was born in Germany and was a decorated chaplain during World War I. When Adolf Hitler became German Chancellor in 1933, Tillich was fired from his position as Professor of Theology at the University of Frankfurt due to his opposition to the Nazi Movement. He migrated to the USA with his family.

According to Bishop Barron, Tillich viewed all of history as swinging like a pendulum from an emphasis on unity to a focus on diversity, then back to unity, and so on. When carried to the extreme, as the Nazis were trying to achieve, God was ignored. Both the Pentecost of Jews and the Pentecost of Christians sought unity under God. Islam has also sought unity under God.

Why then are the world's three major religions still so divided? We all have extreme liberals at one end and extreme conservatives at the other, with the balance of members somewhere in the middle. I found really heavy mental meanderings in my two and one-half mile walk.

The solution seemed so simple. What would happen if we all called on our Higher Power, as members of Alcoholics Anonymous do, and humbly spoke with, learned from, and began to love our enemies? As my coffee cup read, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." That's easy to say, but hard to do.

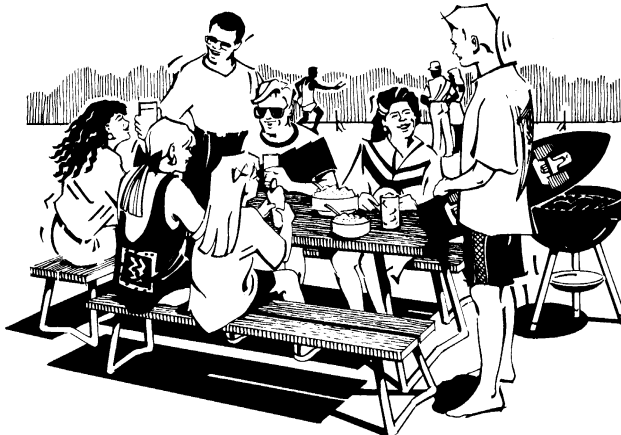

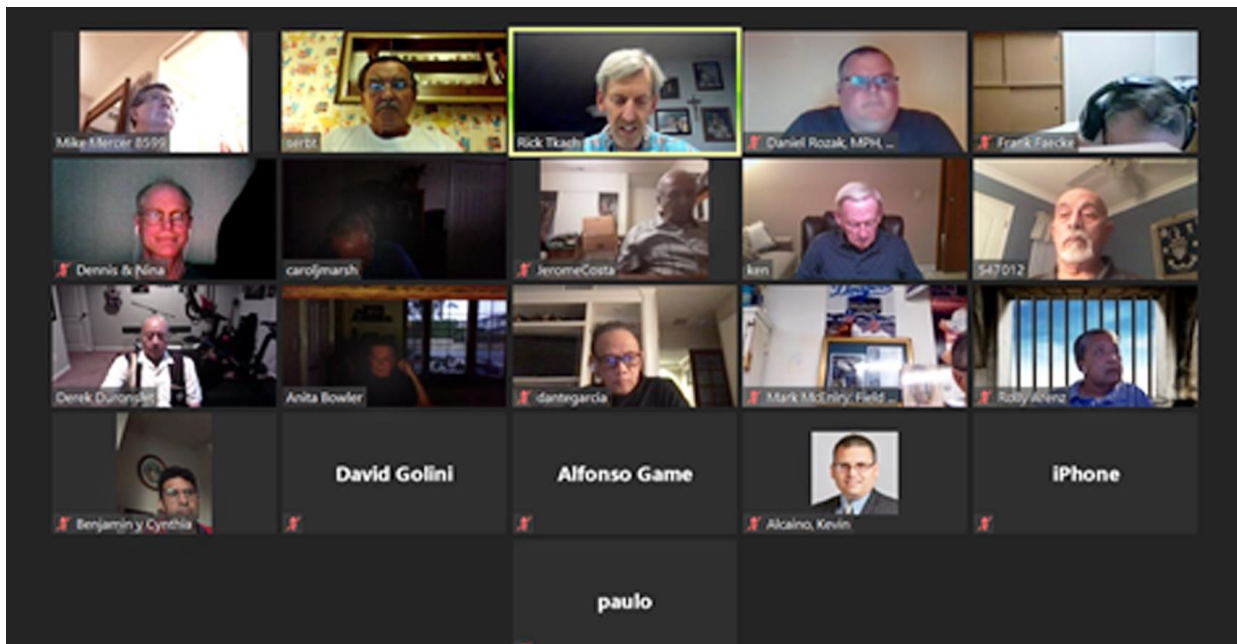

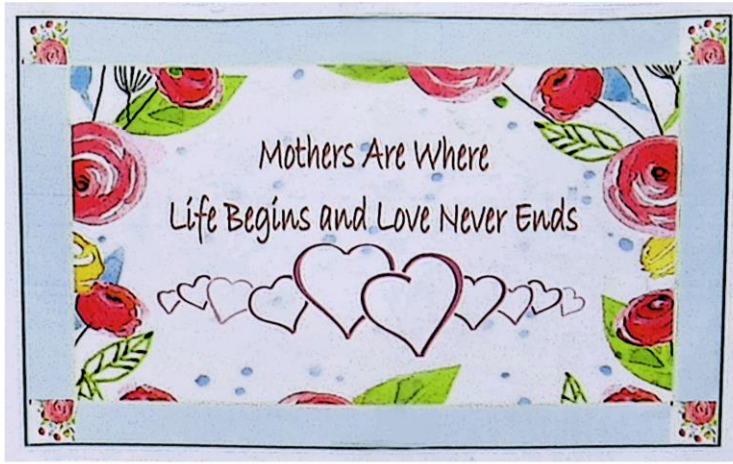
