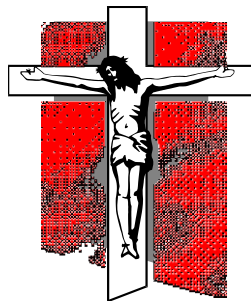

Through the Eyes of a Child

From birth to seven years old 80% of everything a child learns is visual. They process everything through their eyes. Reading, television, laptops and observing the behavior of others especially family. Fathers can be a powerful influence on their children's lives. Paul urges them to *be "strong in the Lord and in the power of His might."* You teach your children far more by how you live than by what you say.

God knows the responsibilities and joys of Fatherhood. He is our Heavenly Father, and as your Father He will give you what you need to care for your children. The greatest gift a father can give to his children is to give of himself. In the polluted moral and spiritual atmosphere we have today our children need the individual attention of a loving father.

God entrusted you with a child or a grandchild. He won't leave you high and dry. *In Philippians 4:6 "Do not worry about anything but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God, and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus"*

Sometimes it seems children will close their ears to your advice but their eyes are still open, and teaching by example can be a very powerful thing. *Proverbs 22:6 Start children off in the way they should go and when they are old they will not depart from it.*

Father's day was first celebrated in 1908 at a local church in West Virginia, 362 men had died in a local coal mine accident and the town's people decided to have a memorial for them. Sixty Two years later they made that day a day to celebrate Fathers and it became a National Holiday.

It doesn't matter whether you answer to "Dad" "Father" or "Grandpa" you've been given an incredible responsibility. But through the eyes of a child you can teach by example. *"Let your requests be made known to God, and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus."* *"And when they are old they will not depart from it."*

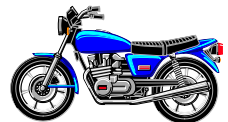

Fathers Day

Father's Day has its roots back to 1909 and a woman named Sonora Smart Dodd. Borrowing on the idea of Mother's Day, she set out to have a day to recognize her father and all fathers.

On June 15, 1966, President Lyndon B. Johnson proclaimed Father's Day to be celebrated on the 3rd Sunday in June. The proclamation stated "in the homes of our Nation, we look to fathers to provide strength and stability which characterizes the successful family." The proclamation further continued "If the father's responsibilities are many, his rewards are also great—the love, appreciation, and respect of children and spouse. It is the desire to acknowledge publicly these feelings we have for the fathers of our Nation that has inspired the Congress to call for the formal observance of Father's Day."

While Mother's Day is celebrated with flowers, brunches and phone calls (and now text messages), Father's Day has historically been about neck ties and coffee mugs with "World's Greatest Dad" imprinted on them.

Second only to being a Catholic man of Faith and being able to receive Christ in the Eucharist, my greatest joy in life has been my role of father and I am certain that I am not alone. The hug around the neck from a child, nurturing your children into adolescents and adulthood. These are memories that I wouldn't trade for anything. As Fathers, we can feel the deepest sorrow for our children when they are hurting but our hearts can also burst with love and pride over watching them make their way in this world. For many, our relationship changes as our children grow into adulthood from Father to adult friend. To be considered a friend by our adult children to me is the meaning of success.

As Catholic men we are blessed not only with our earthly fathers who had faults and fears just as we do, but we have our Lord's adoptive father, St. Joseph and Our Father in Heaven as role models of love and service. Just as we draw close to our Spiritual Mother for her intercession, we can draw close to St. Joseph as a role model of the tender, loving, obedient, courageous father. We have Christ's teaching about obedience to the Father to guide us to do God's will and to be merciful, slow to anger and just.

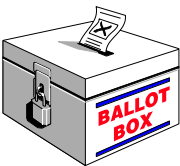

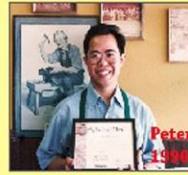

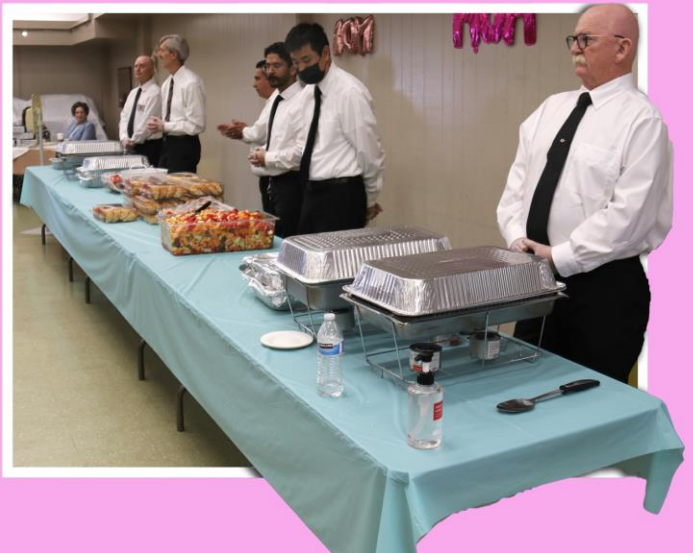
