I hope to see all of you at the monthly business meetings.

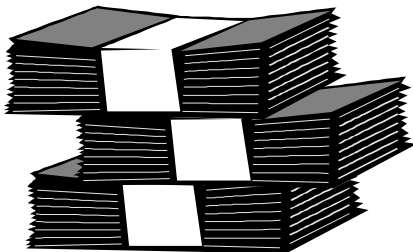

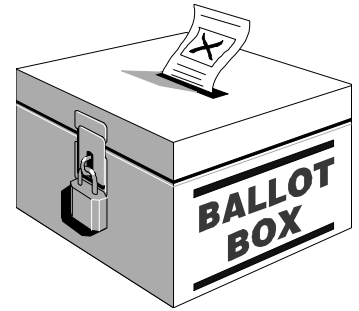

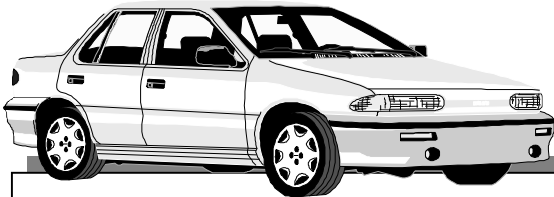
We had a good turnout for the pancake breakfast the council put on for St. Irenaeus School.
