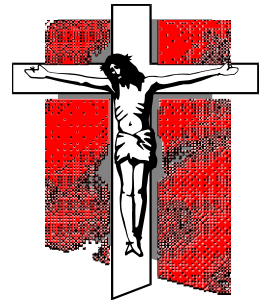

## Here I Am Lord

When Jesus was making His triumphal entry into Jerusalem just a few days before His death *He sent two of His disciples ahead into the village saying go and you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it here. If anyone asks why you are taking him? Just say "The Lord has need of him". Luke 19:30/31*

Sometimes we have the tendency to wonder, Can I still be useful to the Lord? God has work for all of us regardless of our age or our ability. It may be as simple as a onetime task like the disciples in Luke 19: 30/31. Or it could be something that will keep you busy for years. 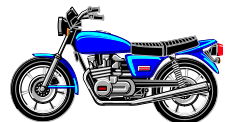

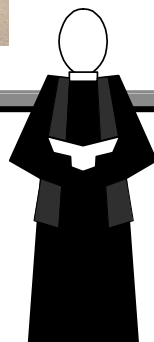
