Brother Knights,




Day of Sharing was a complete success. You could see on the faces of those attendee's that they had a good time. A big Thank You to those of you that helped.


Let's also honor the Moms still with us today and give God thanks for giving us a mom that nurtures and reflects the complete and pure love of God for His children.




