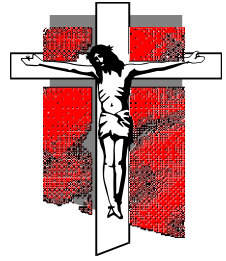

## Mary's Song

Mary is first mentioned in the Bible in *Isiah 7:14*. *"Therefore, the Lord himself will give you a sign: A virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel."* (Immanuel is a Hebrew name that means "God is with us.") This prophecy was fulfilled through Mary in the book of Luke. She is just a young girl living in Nazareth and betrothed to Joseph. The angel Gabriel visits her and tells her she has been chosen by God to give birth to the Messiah. She only asked one question. *"How can this be since I am a virgin?"* *Luke 1:34* Gabriel's answer in *verse 37* was *"For nothing is impossible to God."* Mary believed God and trusted Him with her life. She knew that whatever God's plan was for her she could trust in his word. She said yes to God when she told Gabriel *"I am the Lord's servant, may it be to me as you have said."* (*Luke 1:38*) She never hesitated but said "Yes Lord." The penalty of adultery in those days was death. I'm sure she thought that Joseph could hand her over. But she trusted God with her life and she said "Yes."

Mary had a servant's heart. She believed, trusted and praised God. They call *Luke 1:46-55*, **Mary's song**. *"My spirit rejoices in God my Savior."* (*verse 47*) *"From now on all generations will call me blessed for the Mighty one has done great things for me. Holy is his name."* (*verse 49*) Read all 9 verses they are beautiful." She had an important role in God's plan for our life and our salvation. So remember her this month as we celebrate Mother's Day.

# Message from Your Council.....Recorder



My Brother's

There is a term in the American Lexicon called "Bizarro World". It comes from Action Comics published by DC in April of 1960. Bizarro World is an opposite of Earth where everything is turned up on its head. Ugliness, Division, Crime and Hate are revered on Bizarro World. The Bizarro World itself is cubed shaped because Earth is round.

The world that we are living in feels very much like a Bizarro world. We don't recognize the world around us. Evil, selfishness, abortion, pride, atheism and even crime are celebrated. I have found myself quite distressed and really powerless to do much about it.

The early Church also found itself living in a Bizarro world. In John 17, Jesus is praying to the Father and cries out "I passed your word onto them, and the world hated them, because they belong to the world no more than I belong to the world. I do not ask that you remove them from the world, but to protect them from the Evil one". In Ephesians, 6:12 St. Paul is speaking of putting on the armor of God and states "For our struggle is not with flesh and blood but with the principalities, with the powers, with the world rulers of this present darkness, with the evil spirits in the heavens."

How do we ground ourselves when everything around us is up in the air? Certainly, Reconciliation and Mass are paramount to keeping Christ at the center our lives. But, we have also been given a grace of unity and fraternity in the Knights of Columbus. We are imperfect men living our faith, serving our church and building one another up. And by building one another up we help one another put on the armor of God. We help one another be steadfast in our Faith.

We have a Calendar of Events in the Knights of Columbus that are unique to our Council. These events occur every year and we are called to support them because we are Servants of Christ and our particular home Church of St. Irenaeus. Mother's Day Brunch, Mother's Day Flowers, Veterans Wheel Chair, Intellectual Disabilities (ID) Drive, Church Fiesta and others. At our Monthly Members meeting we are required to get that information out so that our members are aware of the opportunities for service that are coming up. But these meetings are also an opportunity to grow in fraternity.

Fraternity comes from working alongside your Brother Knights and building those bonds of Friendship. Since we are "In the world" we must work to provide for our families and everything that falls on our shoulders. As Catholic men we are not "of the world" and it is important to grow those fraternal relationships so that they are deeper than an arm's length acquaintance. Fellow knights, remember “Memento Mori (Latin for remember that you have to die)?” It’s a rather sombre topic which most of us avoid thinking about. Saint Francis de Sales gives us a beautiful follow up on that in his *Golden Counsels*. He tells us the following: “The words: ‘We must die,’ are harsh, but they are followed by words of great sweetness: ‘in order to be united with God through death.’”

In Bishop Robert Barron’s *Daily Gospel Reflection* of April 24, 2023, he wrote the following:

“Ordinary bread satisfies only physical longing, and it dies so in a transient way: one eats and one must eat soon again. But the heavenly bread, Jesus implies, satisfies the deepest longing of the heart, and does so by adapting the one who eats it to eternal life. The Church Fathers loved to ruminate on this theme of divinization through the Eucharist, the process by which the consumption of the bread of life readies one for life in the eternal dimension.”

Every time we Catholics receive Holy Communion, we are sharing in the divine life of Jesus’ Body and Blood. We are being readied for eternal life, not a sombre thought but a mystery that makes our hearts soar like an eagle!

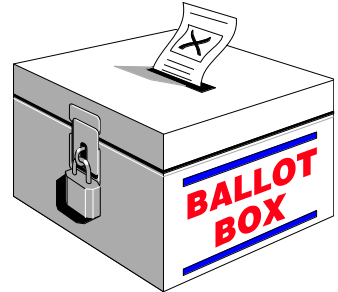

# Pro-Life Information .....



Brothers Knights,

Happy May. I hope you are enjoying Eastertide as much as I am. Every year, the Church navigates us through the Acts of the Apostles during the daily mass. "Acts," as it's commonly referred to, provides us with a look into the past of the early formations of our Church, and the courageous acts of Peter, Paul, Stephen, Philip, and many other apostles and saints to preach the Gospel to all nations. I encourage you to spend the month of May reading this Gospel (yes, it is considered a Gospel). There are 28 chapters and 31 days in May so you only need to read at most 1 chapter per day.

We conclude Easter with Pentecost which is the initiation of the Church and her mission. As Catholics, we are all called to mission - a mission to evangelize and bring people to Christ. From the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

***Mission - a requirement of the Church's catholicity***

***849 The missionary mandate. "Having been divinely sent to the nations that she might be 'the universal sacrament of salvation,' the Church, in obedience to the command of her founder and because it is demanded by her own essential universality, strives to preach the Gospel to all men': "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and Lo, I am with you always, until the close of the age."***

This is a tall order, but it is a calling we are all obliged to answer. There are various ways to participate in the Church's mission and it can be through spoken word or physical acts. Most importantly, I believe, is that we know the scriptures because God's word is the strongest tool we have to evangelize. We come to know God through the scriptures and to know God is to love God. If you haven't acquired the habit of reading the scriptures on a daily basis, reading Acts over the month of May is a good way to begin.

One way the Knights of Columbus shows the community its love of God is through our financial support of pregnancy centers. However, if we were to personally encounter an expectant mother, would we know where to send her for shelter, money for groceries or the nearest pregnancy center? In the same way that knowledge of the scriptures is important to the Church's mission, knowledge of available resources for expectant mothers is also important. I have recently discussed this topic with Astrid Bennett Guitierrez, who runs LA Pregnancy Services, which serves LA and Orange counties. The goal is to create wallet sized information cards that we as Knights and all St. Irenaeus parishioners can carry and distribute as needed to women or fathers we encounter in need of help. More to come on this.

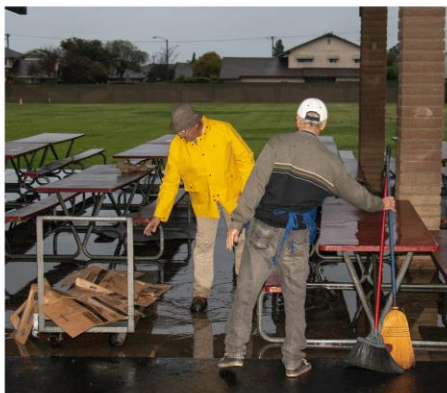

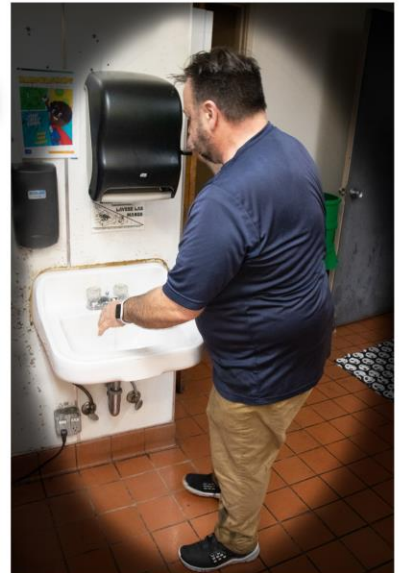
