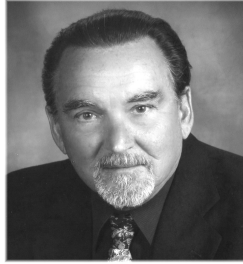

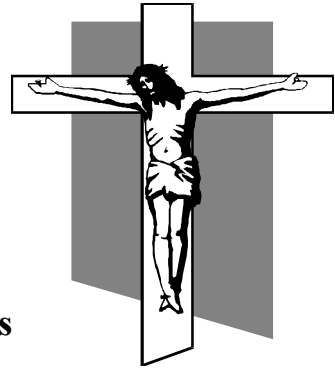

In All Things Give Thanks

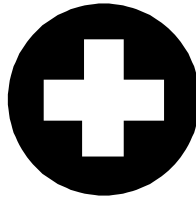

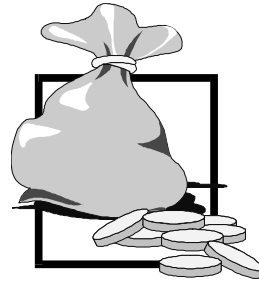

I hope to see all of you at the monthly business meetings.

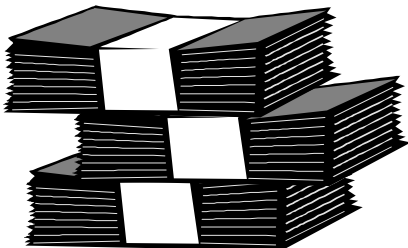

We all know the old adage – the grass seems greener on the other side of the fence. When it comes to replacing your existing Knights of Columbus life insurance with coverage offered by another company, the adage holds true. Perceptions are deceiving. All these factors affect the amount of coverage you'll get for your premium dollar.

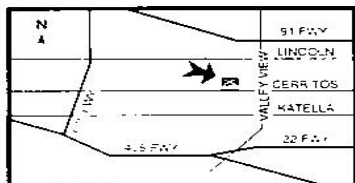

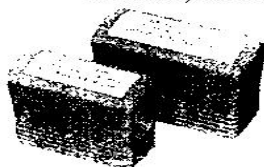
