Council 8599 Knights have been conspicuous as Alter servers for funeral masses and many comments have been made concerning the dignity displayed by our servers. Thank you all who participate.

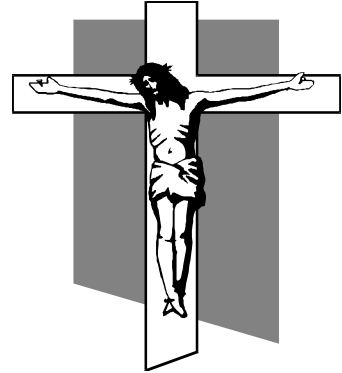
We were disappointed that the Trunk or Treat for the parish children had to be postponed, but our Knights were standing by to help out.

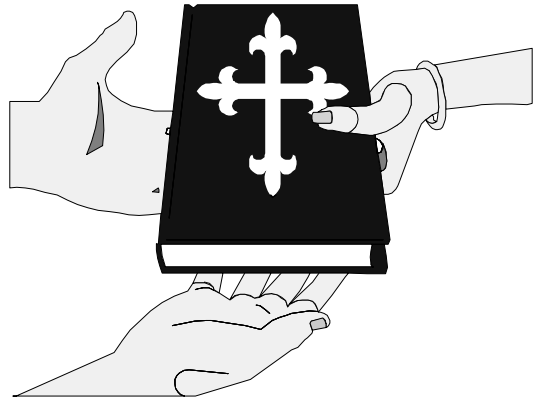

I wish you and your family a Happy Thanksgiving.

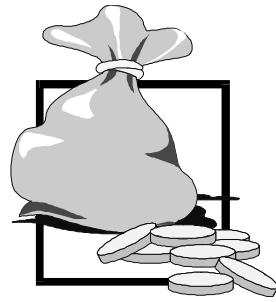

I hope to see all of you at the monthly business meetings.

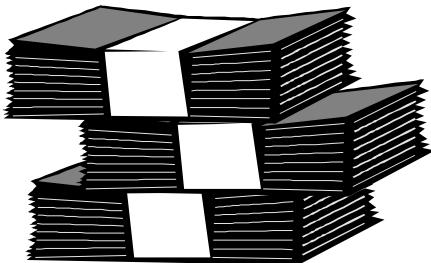

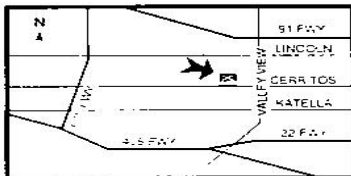

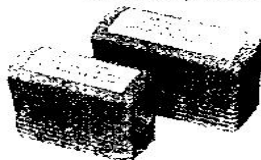
