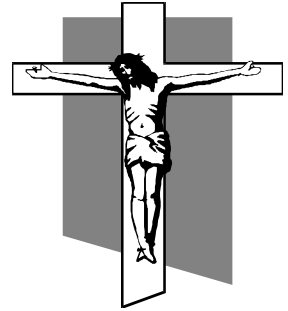

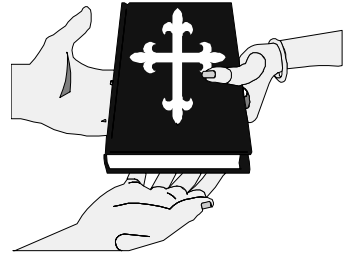
The Holidays Are Here Again - Seasons of the Heart.

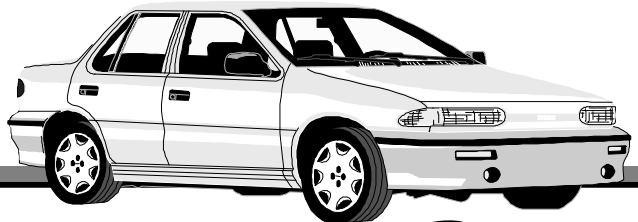
Dear Brother Knights

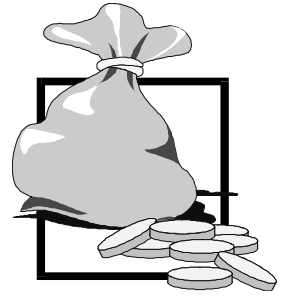

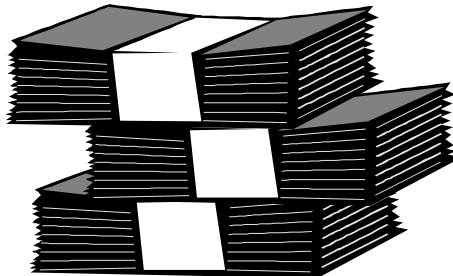

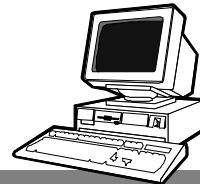

I would like to invite you to join us on some of our trips, we only spend about an hour at the site's. Give us a call.

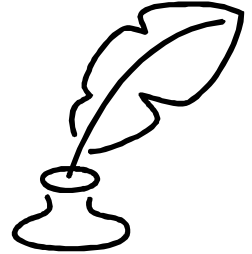

Raising Awareness About Life Insurance

Since 2003, each September has been designated as Life Insurance Awareness Month. 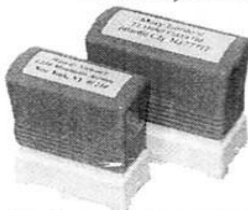
