Brother Knights,

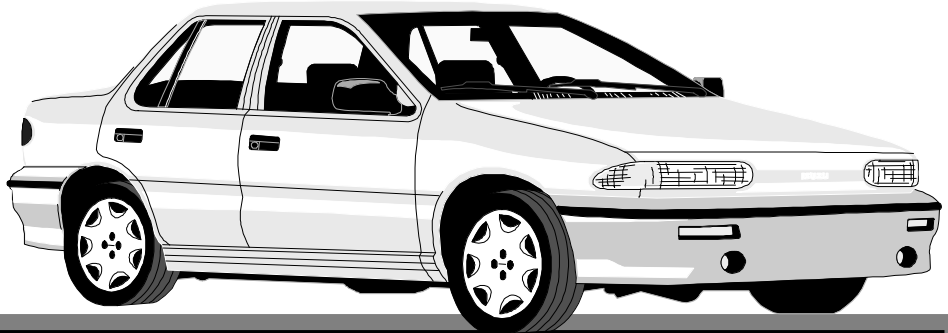

If you have been watching videos put out by The Center for Medical Progress you may have been a little surprised to find out Planned Parenthood is in the business of selling baby parts. 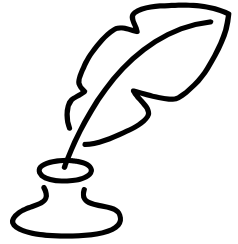
