Who Was THE REAL Margaret Sanger

She founded the largest abortion business, known today as Planned Parenthood.

- Praised pre-war Nazi Germany's eugenic and racist policies, which treated certain people as unworthy of life.
- Promoted "voluntary sterilization or permanent segregation for people she called "morons, imbeciles, criminals, and epileptics."
- Believed many children were a burden and should be avoided by using birth control.
- Lobbied to have government control the size of American families through birth control, sterilization, and birthing licenses.
- Started what she called "The Negro Project" to reduce African American population by pushing birth control.

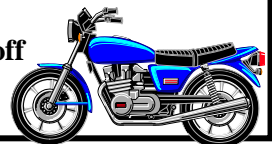

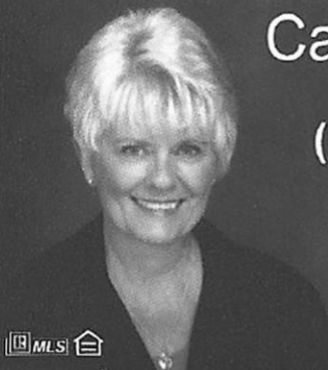
