#### The Power of Prayer





Another doctor in Fort Worth (name not recalled) had me walk to his office one mile from my home three days in a row to take my blood pressure. The walks enabled him to declare my blood pressure was normal so I could pass my physical to work for the F.B.I. in May, 1973.

When I was in my 50s, I developed another hernia, which kept me from walking long distances in downtown Los Angeles to conduct Federal background investigations. The surgeon (name unknown) allowed me to stay overnight at Anaheim Hospital. It was a bad idea! A Mrs. Harris in the room next to mine screamed out each hour complaining of pain. I surely was glad to go home to recover the next day. The supervisory investigator who was my boss had offered to do the surgery with his jack-knife. I declined. He wasn't a great supervisor, much less a surgeon!

Another doctor named Dr. Z was a good doctor of osteopathy who did my yearly physicals. I decided to change doctors after several years. He assigned a young female to clean excessive wax from my ears with forced water. She had never done the procedure before! It was painful and could have burst my eardrums according to my next doctor, Dr. G of St. Jude's Medical. The last straw with Dr. Z was when the bulb on his stethoscope burst because it was so old!

I have offered daily prayers for my friends at St. Irenaeus, especially a particular semiretired Orthopaedic surgeon and his retired nurse wife. She referred me to him, who thought my right leg pain suffered as an usher at Angels Stadium as a hip problem. Dr. Karen Evensen of St. Jude's Medical showed me an X-ray of my missing right hip cartilage. She performed excellent hip replacement surgery at St. Jude Hospital almost eight years ago. A host of therapists, including Christine (former classmate of my son Patrick) have caused me to be pain free! At least one therapist told me Dr. Evensen is a perfectionist.

During the two years of COVID, nurses from St. Jude's and the Wal-Mart pharmacist Alex inoculated my family and me with Moderna vaccines. We all had only one mild case of COVID. My dentist for over 20 years, Dr. V, has had the same staff for years. He has delayed knee surgery so his staff will not have to go on unemployment while he recovers. Everyone on the staff has been my friend, and they have saved my teeth!

In my daily prayers now, I am able to ask our Lord to bless and heal all my doctors and nurses and their medical staffs named in this little story. They and many more have all been my "helpers!"


