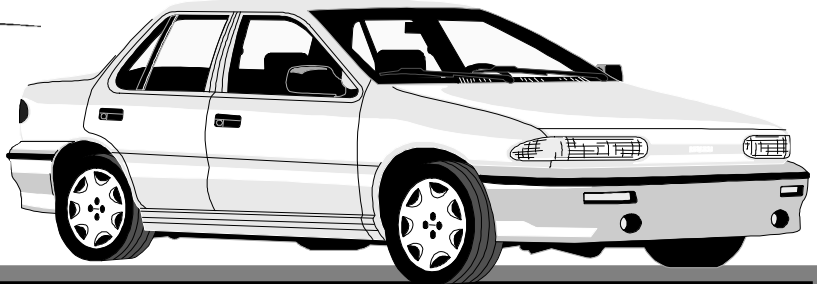
September of course, is when the Blood Drive is in full swing. Every year it gets larger. Thanks to Brother Knight Rolly for doing a fine job.

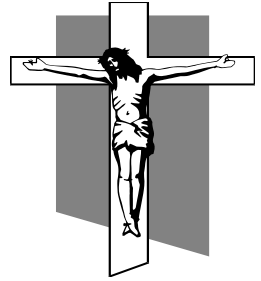

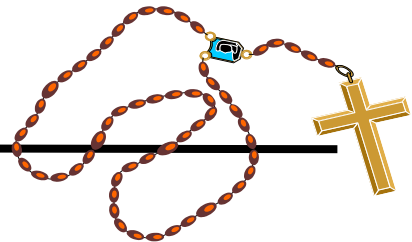
Do Not Lose Heart

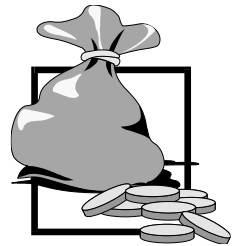

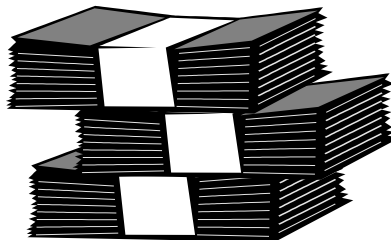

Under Spiritual Works we find "PRAY FOR THE LIVING AND THE DEAD...It is impossible to physically aid the many people-even those in our own families-who need help. But we can reach out to them in prayer. All people, dead or alive, benefit from a remembrance in prayer, including those praying." I try, as I am sure you do, to pray daily for the living and the dead and to entrust them to Jesus' Divine Mercy. Do you know that Jesus revealed to St. Faustina that He comes to us 3 times after we die to invite us to join Him for all eternity? Remember that God is outside of time and everything is the present for Him. Priests from the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception believe that we can say the Divine Mercy chaplet and the graces from that chaplet can be applied to a loved one who has died. Why? Because God knew that we were going to say that chaplet and applied it to that person's soul. How tremendous is the grace of God!

Look at the Corporal Work Bury the Dead. It says, "Plague-ridden bodies no longer litter the streets. Modern funeral practices have taken the details of caring for the dead off our hands. But the personal expression of sympathy, the hug or handshake at the vigil or funeral service, or the donation of food are important for the grieving. The ceremonies remember the dead, but we are expected to support the living in their sorrow." Would you like to join our brother knights in serving funerals at St. Irenaeus? You can serve even if you have never done so before or have not served in years.
