At its 122nd annual meeting in 2004, the Supreme Council resolved that September 11th be observed each year as a World Day of Prayer for Peace.



Remember what Jesus did for you on the cross. He loves you that much.



BRING THEM BACK ALIVE



How many of us have children who no longer practice their Catholic faith? I certainly do. I am almost finished reading RETURN HOW TO DRAW YOUR CHILD BACK TO THE CHURCH by Brandon Vogt with a Forward by Bishop Robert Barron. It can be ordered from Amazon or from Brandon's website directly (cheaper.)

This short introduction cannot do the book justice. I heard of it on Immaculate Heart Radio, 930 AM. Brandon is an award-winning author, blogger, and noted speaker. He works as the Content Director for Bishop Barron's Word on Fire Catholic Ministries.

Before writing this excellent book Brandon did extensive research for a year, talking to experts and hundreds of parents and young people who have left and returned to the Church. As Bishop Barron notes in the Forward, the book presents "...a complete game plan to create the best possible environment to reintroduce your child to Christ and his Church."

Bishop Barron states further, "the Church faces many challenges today, but I am convinced that the most pressing concern, at least in America, is the attrition of our own people. 13% of Americans identify as former Catholics and for every one convert to the Catholic faith, more than six people leave."

Brandon methodically helps us understand the problem (Why are they leaving? Where are they going? The Big Five Myths About Fallen-Away Catholics.) He then presents a careful step by step game plan that has worked in many families to bring our children back to the Catholic Church. Lastly, he addresses The Big Objections-Personal, Moral, and Theological.

In my opinion the book is extremely comforting, helpful, and well thought out. I plan to finish it, re-read it, pray about it, and by the grace of God, put it into practical action.

Why Is Abortion Wrong? Do You Know?

Since 1973, more than 56 million preborn babies have been destroyed due to the legalization of abortion in the United States. That's more people than the entire population of Spain.

Given the current abortion rate, 1 baby is aborted every 30 seconds and 120 babies are aborted every hour. That means that by the time you finish reading one of our anti-abortion articles dozens more preborn babies will be lost. And that's just in the United States. The volume of death represented by abortion is staggering.

Abortion is killing on a genocidal scale.

Abortion Kills Mothers

The procedure of abortion is highly unregulated compared with other invasive medical procedures. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reports [http://www.cdc.gov/mmwr/preview/mmwrhtml/ss6311a1.htm?s_cid=ss6311a1_w] that from 1973 to 2010 over 400 women who underwent legal abortions in the U.S. were killed by the procedure. You may read our abortion articles to learn more.

Dr. Janet Daling and her colleagues conducted a study funded by the National Cancer Institute to explore the connection between abortion and breast cancer. They found [http://www.aaplog.org/position-and-papers/partial-birth-abortion/aaplog-statement-on-the-association-of-induced-abortion-and-the-subsequent-development-of-breast-cancer/] that a woman's risk of developing breast cancer was 50% higher if she had had an abortion. If a woman had had an abortion in her teenage years, then the risk was 100% higher. Get more details on the abortion-breast cancer link from our articles on abortion.

Clearly, if the number of women who have lost their lives to breast cancer that developed as a consequence of a past abortion were included among maternal deaths owing to legal abortion, the death toll for mothers who choose to terminate their pregnancies would be much higher.
