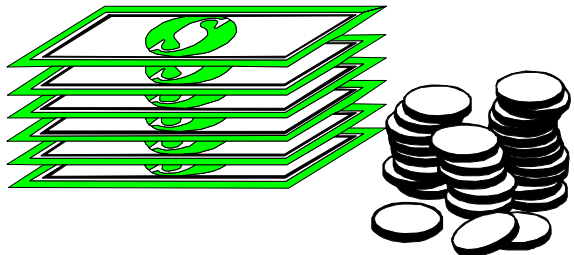

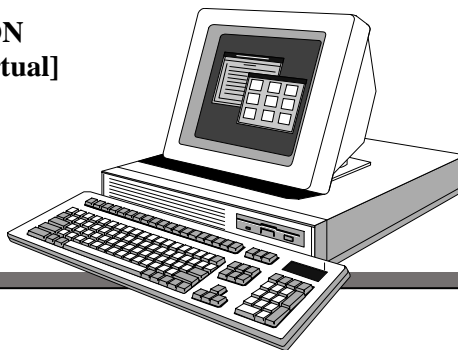

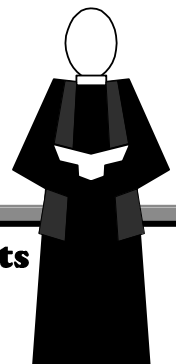

FEAR NOT, FAITH



In 2004, I was ready to go to work at 5:00 am, suddenly I fell in bed with a strong stomach pain. I was living alone, far from my family and no one to ask for help. I laid down with pain until 11:30pm. I was able to move and called a taxi to take me to the emergency room. The doctor ordered me to do an endoscopy, results came back and the doctor told me I needed immediate surgery to rebuild my stomach. The cause: stress, skipping meals, lack of sleep, ANGER!

After the surgery, I was discharged from the hospital. Three days later, while recovering, I got into a big argument, I got all upset and angry, and started feeling sick again, ran to bathroom to throw up bile. Since then, I was sick every 6 months.

A year later felt sick again, this time I spent almost 2 years in bed. Every month my stomach couldn't hold anything, no eating, no drinking, for 10 days each time, until I could hold food again.

Over the years I was getting better, with relapses of once or twice a year. Doctors could not find anything. All kind of tests, analysis were done, took all kind of medicines and nothing, tried various methods, classes, cures and the problem always came back.

I was raised Catholic but my faith was nowhere to be found, I was a non-practicing Catholic. I only called on "My God" when I needed him.

It wasn't until two Septembers ago when my parents took me to see a priest (Padre Armando Lopez) and talked to him about my life. He listened to me for about an hour. At the end of my talk, he asked me if I wanted him to pray for me; and I said "yes". At that moment, I opened my HEART to JESUS CHRIST, I stood up and opened my arms; as the priest began praying, he anointed me with oil in the palms of my hand and when he touched my forehead and made the sign of the cross; I felt my heart beating so fast, I felt so much pressure on my chest and head, and couldn't feel my legs; I got scared and I thought I was going to fall down or die or something. I was so scared! At the same time, I felt some type of "energy" coming down from my head, through my body, to my legs, and felt "something coming out of my body". I felt a huge relief, my body relaxed and a wonderful sense of peace. I just started crying, feeling emotional, and I just couldn't stop. I hugged the priest and felt "God My Father" hugging me and inside me I heard his voice telling me, "Don't worry I love you and I'm always with you". After some minutes, the father asked me what I felt and I couldn't explain what just happened. He said: "It was The Holy Spirit that got into you".

That was only a jump start, now it was my responsibility to keep the motor ON and GOING!!! After the wonderful miracle of receiving the Holy Spirit again, I went back to my home Church, went to mass that weekend. During the mass, they announced a retreat for couples the following weekend. Me and my now wife attended and the miracles continued. During the retreat they announced a class for couples. My family and I started taking the class every Friday and became part of the marriage ministry at "Our Lady of Victory Parish".

Being there we realized that as a couple with family, we needed the Sacrament of Marriage, we started our marriage preparation (classes every week, retreats, conferences, congresses, etc.).

Our plan was to get married at Our Lady of Victory but God had other plans for us. We ended up meeting with Father Ed Broom (Padre Escobita) at St. Peter Chanel and there he assigned to us a great family to prepare us; they said 3 months, which became almost 11 months. I was so desperate at midway, but it was all planned by God, He was getting us ready and finally we received the Holy Sacrament of Marriage in St. Peter Chanel Catholic Church on September 10, 2016.

We thought, yes, we made it but then we realized that it was just the beginning and needed to prepare a lot more to face any tribulations with FAITH, HOPE and LOVE, regardless the type or origin.

After coming back to God, to my faith, getting married and really start living as a Catholic, I was completely healed from my sickness. The sacraments are the greatest medicines.

I have realized that I still have a lot of room in me for improvement and to grow in my Faith, in my relation with God, my family, my friends, my co-workers, my clients, my brothers in Christ, even my enemies. That I need to get better every day and enjoy my loved ones every second as I love God, My Lord and King Jesus Christ.

I asked myself and I've heard: When I come back from a sickness, accident, hardship, tribulation, etc... there is always a purpose or a plan, but what really is that plan for me? God's answer was "The Cross" to give us His ONLY SON to die for us and SAVE OUR SOULS.

My answer is Christ, who in the unity of the Holy Spirit and my Almighty Father, it's only one God, who lives and reigns for ever and ever. AMEN!!!

May the answers to my prayers be what God wants from me, and knows is better, and not only what I want. Nowadays, when we are faced with tribulation, I look to ***Jesus Christ on the cross***, and remember that He died for me and that all my pains together will never compare to what he suffered for me. I give to my Lord all my **fears, pain and suffering** as an ***offering*** and when I get up, he always takes care of me. Then I come back to ***look at the cross and give thanks***, and when I see Him, He looks at me but this time with His hands wide open and a huge smile on His face he tells me: "*see, I told you*"

Dear brother/sister, I have no idea why I'm opening myself to share my testimony to you, there was no plan. But I'm pretty sure about one thing, God is using me as an instrument to send His word to you.

"Don't be afraid to let God love you and transform you into the saint He created you to be!"

May God always Bless You and your Family!

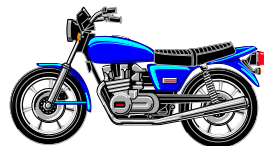
