God bless you all and may the Lord keep you and your family safe.

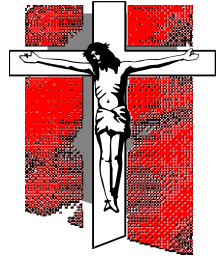

COUNCIL CHAPLAIN'S Corner



Safe in the Arms of God

Esther (Etty) Hillesum was living in Amsterdam just before the German occupation started. She was born on January 15, 1914. She died at Auschwitz concentration camp on November 30, 1943. Many books have been written about her describing both her religious awakening and the persecution of the Jewish people. As she awaited the inevitable, and with a fear of the unknown she was introduced to the Bible and as she began reading it somewhere along the way she met Jesus. Once she found Him her life began to change. She placed her hand in His and found the strength and courage to carry on. She started her Diaries in 1941 at St. Augustine.

Her diaries formed a record of oppression from the German army but also told of her spiritual development and deepening faith in God. One of her entrees: "From all sides our destruction creeps up on us and soon the ring will be closed and no one will be able to come to our aid. But I don't feel I'm in anybody's clutches. I feel safe in Gods arms, and weather I am sitting at my beloved old desk in the Jewish district or in a labor camp under SS guard. I shall feel safe in Gods arms. Once you have begun a walk with God, you need only to keep on walking with Him, and all life becomes one long stroll."

One of Etty's Quotes:

"Ultimately we have just one moral duty: to reclaim large areas of peace in ourselves, more and more peace, then reflect that peace toward others. The more peace there is in us the more peace there will be in this troubled world."

Just three months before her death she threw a postcard with her final words on it, out of a train. "Opening the bible at random I find this." "The Lord is my high tower..." Thank you for your kindness and care. A Dutch farmer found her card sometime after her death. It is now safe as is her Diary. Those words came from II Samuel 22: 1-4. "The Lord is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer, in Him will I trust: He is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my savior." What a scripture to just randomly find, what a comfort that must have been.

One scripture I would like to add for today's tumultuous times. Psalms 56: 2-3-4 "My adversaries pursue me all day long: In their pride many are attacking me. When I am afraid, I put my trust in you. In God whose word I praise. In God I trust and am not afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?"

You can be confident about tomorrow if you walk with God today.

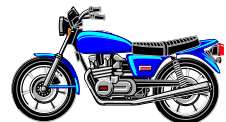

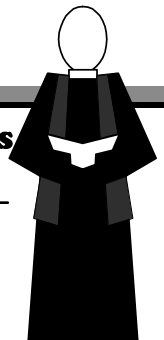

SNEAKY SCAM & SURPRISE DONATIONS

On Monday, August 9, 2021, I received a text from our pastor, Father Binh Nguyen, asking for a “favor.” *That was strange.* Father Binh has never sent me a text like that. Nevertheless, I quickly responded, “Sure, Father Binh, what do you need?”

In the next text he asked me to purchase a few \$100 I-Tune gift cards for cancer patients, saying he would gladly repay me. My investigator background caused a huge red flag to shoot up! I immediately telephoned St. Irenaeus Rectory and told the receptionist Pat what was happening. She seemed surprised and said Father Binh was on vacation. I gave her the 714 telephone number from which the text came. Pat said it was not Father Binh’s number, and she connected me with Office Manager Carlos.

While Carlos and I were talking, Pat received another call from another officer of the Knights of Columbus besides me. Carlos and I realized that K of C officers from the parish were being targeted by a scammer. How did someone get my cell phone number to send the text and how did they connect it to my name?

My number is on a brochure inside St. Irenaeus Church asking for vehicle donations. The same type of brochure is publically posted in the church patio, but neither posting has my name. How did the scammer get two other officers names and cell phone numbers?

I forwarded the fraudulent text to AT&T, and all K of C members were alerted by email to the attempted scam. Carlos made sure the church bulletin contained a warning to parishioners to be wary of any questionable request from the church or its organizations.

The final text message from the scammer to me read, “Frank, are you still there? What happened to you?” I just went silent and let the scammer figure it out.

On the Good News side, I received a surprise text from Denis, Founder and CEO of Ave Maria Catholic Vehicle Donations on Wednesday, August 11. Ave Maria is the non-profit through which our Knights of Columbus Council receives money for vehicle donations. Denis said that our K of C Council would be receiving two checks totalling \$3,875 from two donated vehicles. Those are the largest checks we have gotten!

For over five years we have asked for vehicles to be donated and turned into cash for 501-c3 charities. Our donations have included over forty vehicles ranging from old cars that won't run to newer used cars that do run to trucks and campers and even a motorized water ski vehicle. Our most unusual donation was a 1964 Studebaker truck with camper. Reportedly, they were rusted and in terrible condition. Surprisingly, we received about \$1,400 after expenses were deducted for towing and auction costs.

We have given over \$12,000 to three charities: St. Irenaeus Church, St. Irenaeus School, and HOPE (Helping Ordinary People Everyday.) HOPE has provided food and clothing and financial assistance to thousands of families regardless of their faith or religion. Many charities have taken large amounts from donations to pay for advertising. Ave Maria has not paid for advertising, and our work has been done by volunteers.

Actually, both stories were Good News! We didn't get scammed, and we did receive generous checks for 501-c3 charities!
