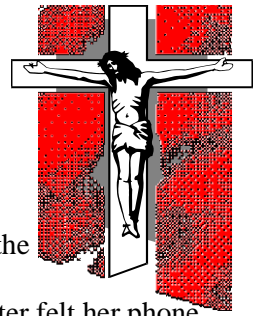
As stated above, we need 4 more new members, please get those Form 100 signed. I have recruitment flyers and Form 100 if you need them.

Inspirational Father's Day Story

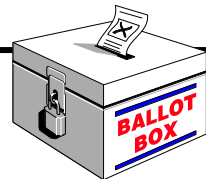

Here is an Inspiring Catholic quote to guide our daily living:

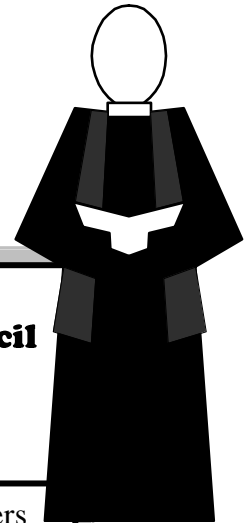

Information of Interest



A radical pro-abortion bill that advocates introduced recently in Congress could legalize even the horrific late-term abortions that Philadelphia abortionist Kermit Gosnell performed before he was jailed for murder. The Women's Health Protection Act as it is called would make abortion on demand the law of the land, and prohibit any limits on abortions up to birth. It means no abortion bans.

But what exactly does "no bans" mean in reality? The sponsors refused to say. But advocates did say was that the bill would mean "no heartbeat bills" such as the ones in Georgia and Ohio or any other "non-medical restrictions on our bodies." The bill actually would go much further, even toppling a Pennsylvania law that prohibits abortions after 24 weeks. It potentially could allow partial-birth abortions again as well. This bill could mean that horrific abortion practices such as Gosnell's could be legal.

... notorious abortionist Kermit Gosnell was convicted in 2013 for killing 21 infants in utero (in addition to his conviction for murdering three infants with scissors after they had been born). Indeed, [the new bill] would wipe almost all state limits on abortion, including mandatory waiting period and ultrasound requirements, off the books.

... What's the moral difference between what Kermit Gosnell did to babies born alive and a legal abortion at 23 weeks? That's a question abortion advocates could not answer after Gosnell was convicted in 2013. The abortion advocates were asked "If abortions should be allowed after viability on healthy mothers with healthy unborn babies" the question was avoided, but responded with "You know, we just can't engage in speculation". After producing evidence that these late-term abortion cases are not just "speculation," they did not respond, according to the report. This isn't a gotcha question, It's a question about fundamental human rights. There are likely thousands of elective abortions performed later than 20 weeks into pregnancy each year. Yet abortion advocates will not talk about them, even as they introduce legislation to make them legal across the country. Abortion activists claimed that the Kermit Gosnell horrors were an anomaly. But if they succeed in passing laws to allow unrestricted, unregulated abortion on demand once again, they could allow back alley abortionists like Gosnell to practice on main street, unhindered and unchecked.



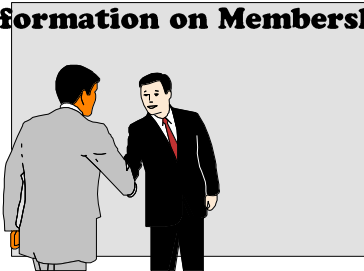

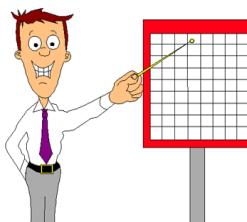
