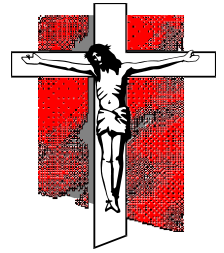

My dear brothers,

As we head into February, I want to thank each of you who supported the Warm Coat Drive. The St. Irenaeus tradition, begun by Deacon Jerry and carried on by Deacons Vernon and Israel, continues to bless those in our immediate community, with coats reaching people in need the very next week. It truly is a blessing to be part of this work.

The HOPE food distributions will take place on February 7 and February 21. Those who come to HOPE receive top-quality food and produce, and the distribution itself is a well-oiled machine. Our presence, our hands and feet, help fill in any gaps and helps it run even better. Distribution begins at 7:00 AM behind the ED building.

Our Member Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, February 18, which is also Ash Wednesday. If possible, please receive your ashes earlier in the day and attend the meeting, as we will be putting the final touches on opening night of the Fish Fry.

If Ash Wednesday is the 18th, that means Tuesday the 17th is Shrove Tuesday (Fat Tuesday). As is our tradition, the Knights will cook pancakes and sausage for the schoolchildren beginning at 5:00 AM. We may need to reset the hall afterward. I am hoping the oven will be repaired by then, but if not, we may need to warm the pre-cooked sausage using griddles and the stovetop. Please be prepared for a little extra work if that is the case.

All of this leads us to Friday, February 20, the first night of the Fish Fry! Like Fiesta, this is truly an all-hands-on-deck event (and then some). We need approximately 25 volunteers each night to run it well. Preparation begins Thursday evening, when we prep the kitchen by laying out pans and utensils, filling containers with tartar sauce and ketchup, and doing whatever we can to shave time off Friday before service begins at 4:30 PM.

In January, I was blessed to attend the men's retreat at Mater Dolorosa. It was a beautiful weekend of reflection and learning how God continues to wait for us, even when we turn away. Sometimes we turn away when things are good, forgetting that everything is a gift from God. Other times we turn away when life is difficult, because many of us were raised to believe we must take care of everything ourselves. We are men, after all. We are fixers and doers.

But as a priest once told me, human shoulders are not designed to carry heavy burdens alone. God will never impose His will on us, but He is always waiting patiently for us to return and seek His help.

As I sat in my room reflecting on these lessons, my heart was filled with words that perfectly capture the spirit of our service as Knights and the grace that comes from serving alongside our brother Knights.

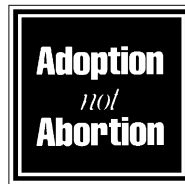


Ash Wednesday is the 18th of February. Please pray for a successful collection of baby items for expectant moms. Also pray for all human lives to be from birth to natural death.

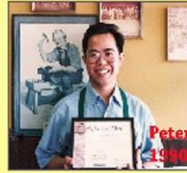

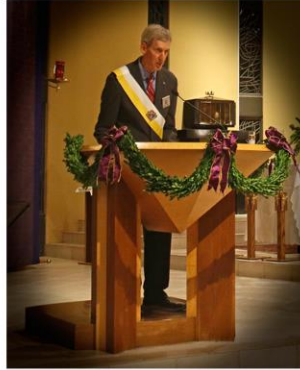
