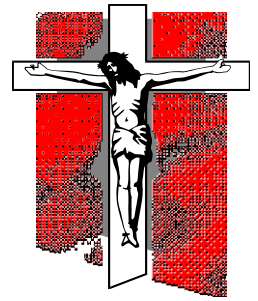

He Is Risen

Paul wrote in *I Corinthians 15:17* “*If Christ has not risen, your faith is futile, you are all still sinners.*” Because Jesus conquered sin and death, when we put our faith in Him, we will share in His resurrection. The full significance of the suffering Christ went through on our behalf is beyond comprehension. He provided a way of releasing us from external punishment.

In *Exodus 27: 1-8* God tells His people how to build a sacrificial alter. Bronze in the Bible stands for divine judgment of sin. The shedding of the lamb’s blood on the alter symbolized the results of sin. Looking forward we will see that Jesus would become the substitute, the sinless “Lamb of God” that would shed His blood for all mankind. When He died on the cross, His sacrifice alone would be enough to atone for the sins of us all. In *John 1:29* John proclaims upon seeing Jesus approaching “*Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world.*”

WHERE IS GOD?

By Frank Faecke

It's a question that has been asked throughout the ages by wise and simple human beings. I would like to introduce you to a simple but astounding person I discovered several years ago but just recently discovered again by surprise through his story. The true story of Brother Lawrence appeared in *Give Us This Day* when I read it on Thursday, February 12, 2026. Please join me in this short story as follows:

“Brother Lawrence of the Resurrection
Carmelite Lay Brother (1611-1691)

Of the early life of Brother Lawrence, little is known. Born in French Lorraine, he served briefly in the army and saw action in the Thirty Years' War. One cold midwinter day in the presence of a leafless tree, he suddenly thought that soon this tree would be covered again with leaves. This thought filled him with 'a high view of the providence and power of God.' Eventually he found his way to the Carmelites in Paris and was admitted as a lay brother.

He spent the next forty years in the monastery kitchen and died at the age of eighty. He accomplished no great deeds and left no writings aside from a few letters. But he happened to make a great impression on a Church official who accompanied the cardinal on a visit to the monastery. A record of their conversations and letters was later published as *The Practice of the Presence of God*. Through this book, Brother Lawrence emerged as a great spiritual master. His method was to cultivate at all times a consciousness of the presence of God. In this spirit, no matter our circumstances, we could find ourselves in a constant state of prayer or conversation with God. There was no special distinction between traditional spiritual disciplines and the daily tasks with which he was occupied: scrubbing pots or chopping vegetables. It was well to go to church, in which to return and dwell. 'Our sanctification,' he believed, 'did not depend upon changing our works, but in doing for God's sake that which we commonly do for our own.'

‘God regards not the greatness of the work, but the love with which it is performed.’
Brother Lawrence”

What a simple approach to God! I wondered if we could damage nature or our neighbour or displease God if we just followed Brother Lawrence's practice of finding God always and everywhere. Who of us could not follow such a simple yet profound practice? What would our family lives, our communities, our government, or our churches be like if we did so? I plan on rediscovering Brother Lawrence's way this Lent. Will you follow me?

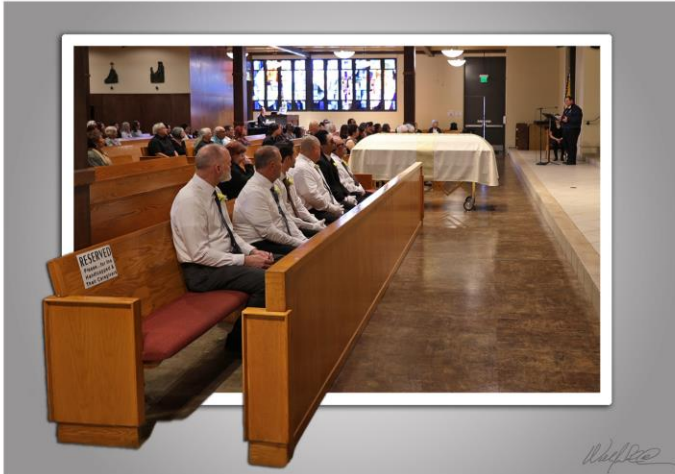

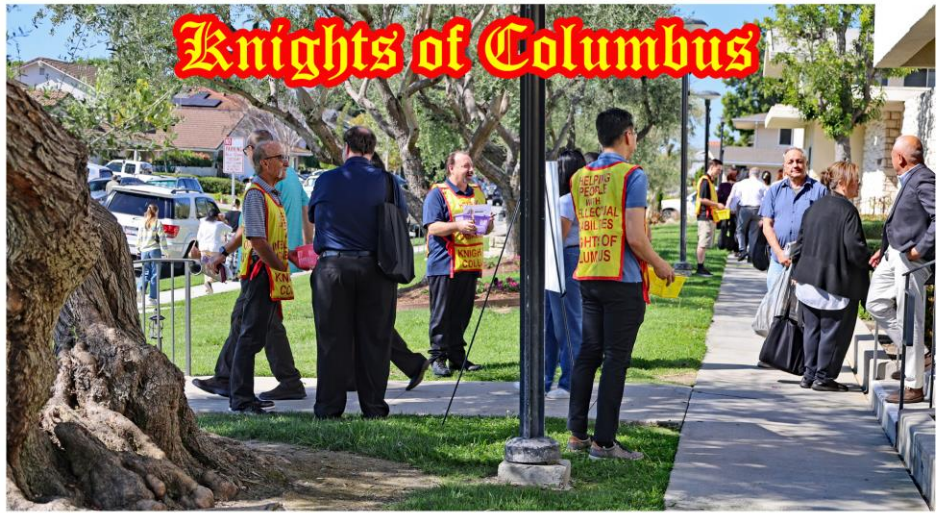
