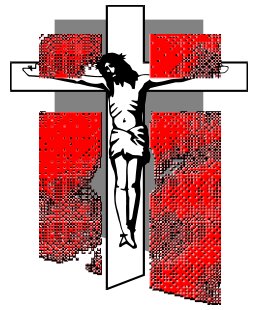

PENTECOST AT DISNEYLAND

On Sunday, May 24, 2026, my family and I went to Disneyland. We had gone to mass the evening before. However, Disneyland is only seven miles from the dangerous chemical leaking tank at Garden Grove, California. It could still explode! Why chance it?

We had planned the outing before the unexpected threat seven miles from Disneyland. Because Disney was monitoring the situation, we decided to go to the “Happiest Place on Earth,” even though we weren’t ready to meet our Maker.

I learned from my lector workbook that Pentecost was already a big day for Jewish People. It was called the Feast of Weeks, one of the three obligatory pilgrimages prescribed in Deuteronomy. Jews from every nation under heaven were in Jerusalem to celebrate God’s giving of the law at Mount Sinai. In the Acts of the Apostles, the Holy Spirit came down on the disciples in the Upper Room, as well as on men and women gathered in Jerusalem. It was the Church’s birthday!

I began to see parallels between Pentecost and Disneyland. When we visited they were celebrating Disneyland’s 70th birthday! Disneyland began in Anaheim, California and has spread all over the world. The Disneyland in Anaheim has had visitors from everywhere! I noticed people from different races, cultures, religions, and languages. Bear with me as we walk along at Disneyland.

We entered it at 9 am and were surrounded by visitors from near and far! We wondered how the day would unfold. We had park hopper tickets; so we could move from the newer area called Disney California Adventure to the older Disneyland Park nearby.

Our daughter Renee explained that part of Disney California Adventure was set up to resemble Los Angeles, California when Walt Disney arrived there in the 1930s. We saw a beautiful 1937 Rolls Royce. I knew Walt didn’t have that much money then; so I asked a cast member (Disney employee), who confirmed that it wasn’t his car. An older lady dressed like a cast member from the 1950s approached us and said that the small dog puppet she held had been a rescue dog that she saved. We began to enter the beautiful world of make believe that Walt Disney and others created!

This Pentecost day could also take us back in time over 2,000 years ago when the Holy Spirit in a dramatic scene gave Mother Mary and the disciples a deep dose of true LOVE!

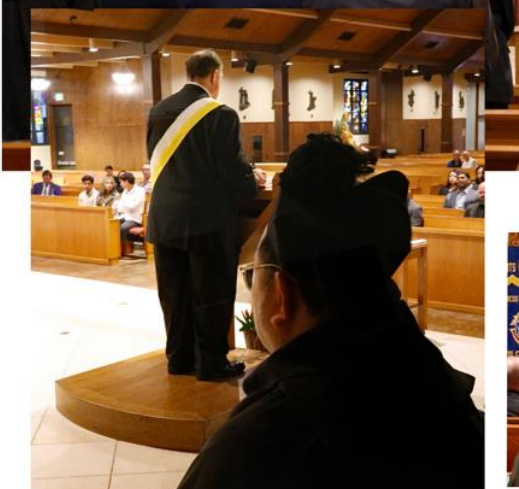
