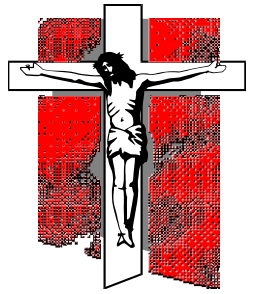

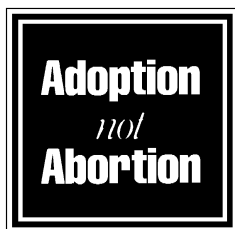
Pro-Life Information
