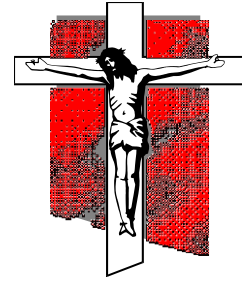

## *Trusting God*

While speaking with a friend, we began to discuss how important it is when we pray, that we listen for God's voice and trust what he says. She said she had been praying for a friend's daughter who had just had a baby. The doctors had told them before the baby was born that he would be facing two challenges at birth. One was life threatening and the other a possible birth defect. Her friend had asked her to pray for the family and especially for the baby. She said for three months she faithfully prayed every night before bed. She would visualize herself at the throne of God praying for this little one and placing him in the arms of God. She would always end her prayer with "Please take care of this little one Lord while I sleep and I will come and get him in the morning." When the time came for delivery the doctor said things looked worse than he had thought and the baby would need to go into surgery immediately. They told the family to be prepared for the worst. My friend said instead of trusting God she immediately began to grumble. "Why God?" I prayed for a miracle and now things are worse than before. She heard God's voice say "Why do you not trust me?" Her first reaction was, that cannot be God, I did trust him and there is no miracle. She said it seemed like hours before the surgery team came out with good news, it seems when they got into the problem area they found it to be less problematic than they had originally thought and everything had gone smoothly. **He was going to be fine. There was her miracle.** She had expected the baby to be born perfect in every way since she had prayed so long and so hard. She had prayed expecting everything to look the way she wanted it to look and in doing so she had almost missed the miracle. ***Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding.***

## WHAT HAVE WE DONE?

My *Give Us This Day* book under the heading “Blessed Among Us” told me the following on June 23, 2025 about incredible Mattie J.T. Stepanek, poet and peacemaker (1990-2004): “If he had lived past his fourteenth birthday, if science had discovered a cure for the rare mitochondrial disorder that had previously claimed his three older siblings, Mattie Stepanek would have liked to be an ambassador for peace, sharing a message of love and hope with all humanity. But he died on June 22, 2004.

Mattie was raised by his mother, who discovered only after her children’s births that they all shared the same disorder. Mattie expected his life would be short, and with that knowledge he embraced each day as a gift, with a purpose. He published several volumes of his poems, the first of which made the *New York Times* bestseller list. He called them ‘Heartsongs’-a call to each person to remember ‘their unique reason for being.’

By that time, Mattie had already left a wide mark on the world. After his First Communion he became a lector in his parish, and by nine he was teaching CCD classes. He spoke widely about his experience and what it felt like to be ‘living while also dying.’ After appearing on Oprah Winfrey’s show, she named him one of her all-time most memorable guests. His hero Jimmy Carter, who gave the eulogy at his funeral and edited his posthumous book, *Just Peace*, said that Mattie was the most extraordinary person he had ever known. There was no doubt, President Carter said, that Mattie was ‘an angel of God, a messenger of God.’ His message was simple. ‘He called everyone to be ‘a peace seeker, a peace maker, a peace bringer.’ Life brings storms, he said, but ‘remember to play after every storm.’

*‘Think gently, speak gently, live gently.’-Mattie J. T. Stepanek”*

What if his mom had aborted him? What a loss to so many lives he touched! What if Beethoven’s mother had aborted her 13<sup>th</sup> child, born to her and his alcoholic dad? We’d have lost such beautiful music to our world! Who knows what all aborted babies would have done for the People of God and the world! Even Judas Iscariot, who turned traitor on Jesus Christ as he smothered him with kisses, was not condemned by Jesus or the Catholic Church!

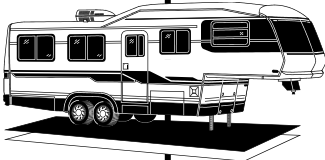

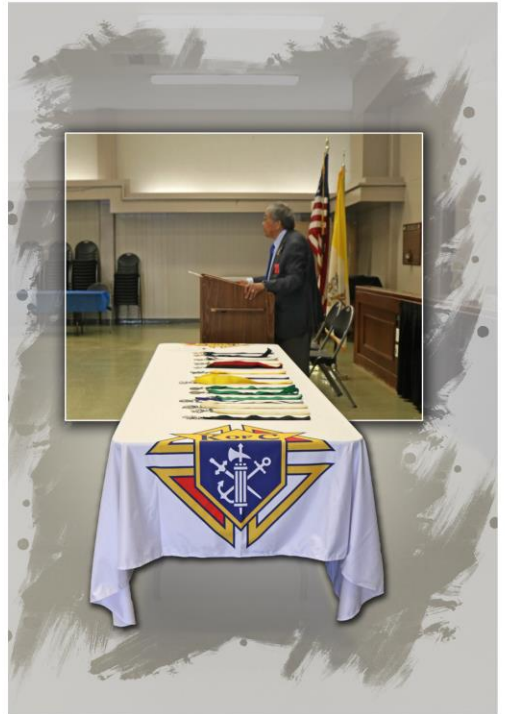
