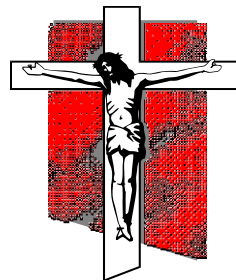

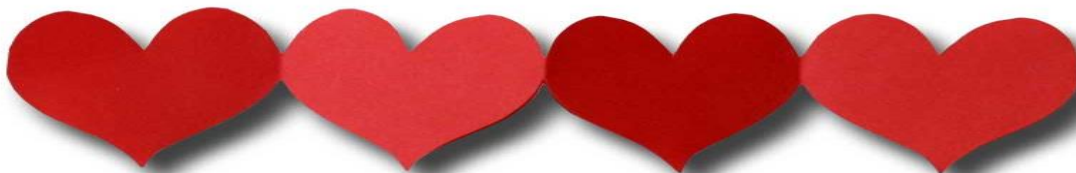

Dear Brother Knights,

Did you receive your 2025 Dues Statement via Email from Knights of Columbus? If not, please contact Mike Mercer, Financial Secretary, at (714) 943-3734.

Thank you to all the brothers who have paid their annual dues from the emailed statement. Many used the Zelle option now available. You saved the Financial Secretary a lot of time and expense printing, folding, envelope stuffing, stamping, and mailing.

Our Council now has 166 members, with 115 being regular members, 3 have “*Honorary*” status, and 41 have “*Honorary Life*” status. “*Honorary*” status is bestowed by Supreme Council on members who have at least 25 years of consecutive service and turn 65 years old. “*Honorary Life*” status is achieved when an Honorary member turns 70.

Due to problems with some members getting their dues notice, the drawing for early dues payment will be done at our February Members Meeting on February 19th. The winner will have their \$32.00 dues refunded.

The name drawn for Good of the Order in January was Sam Glorioso, but unfortunately, he was not present. Next month’s drawing jackpot be **\$50.00**.

Thank you, also, to those of you who returned your Fraternal Survey Forms, as the information contained in them is especially important for Supreme to maintain our designation as an IRS recognized charity. This form has changed significantly from previous years due to the Faith in Action programs, which include activities specific to Faith, Family, Community, and Life.

Stay on the lookout for details about our **Lenten Fish Fry’s**, which will begin **March 7th**. Come volunteer to help and join in the fellowship with your brother Knights, as an enjoyable time is had by all. Bring your families and all your friends, as we need to have good turnouts.

My dear Brothers!

Well done on the Warm Clothing Drive. I witnessed brothers working together to sort the truly incredible amount of clothing and blankets donated by the Parish. What I always notice is the joy in which we carry out our acts of service together. Thank you to all who helped with sorting, bagging and moving the clothes to storage and helping to distribute them to the community.

In between Christmastide and the season of Lent, the Church gives us a period of Ordinary Time with which we come up for air before we dive into Lent and prepare for Easter. So let us take that breath and give thanks to God for all of the blessings that he gives to us and for our Council's work in 2024 in God's glory.

Ash Wednesday is March 5 and so our next big event is the Parish Fish Fry. This event originally began as a way to serve a Fish Fry dinner to those who were coming to attend Stations of the Cross and that is why we traditionally served dinner from 5 to 7 PM. And that is still a very important part of our mission.

It is my desire that you experience this grace and that it strengthen you in faith and in fraternity.

Father Febin Barose, Retreat Center Director and Director of Ministry at Mater Dolorosa Passionist Retreat Center in Sierra Madre, California has updated us former retreatants from January 8th, 2025. Our beloved retreat center nestled in the foothills of the Sierra Madre Mountains has been attacked by the Eaton wildfire!

Young Father Febin has been there three years and in 2024 became its director. On January 8th after dinner, he told us in an e-mail later that he and the staff and 60 retreatants had to flee from the center just before the fire hit them. Although it burned three buildings, heroes from the local fire department saved the main dormitory building by dosing it with water.

For now our Men's Retreat group from St. Irenaeus parish along with other men from other parishes won't be driving there this January for our yearly retreat. The retreats will all be cancelled until the massive restoration takes place. Father Febin said he will by God's grace rebuild the retreat center, which has helped thousands of men, women, and high school youth for over 100 years! He and the Passionist priests and staff have the faith and love from the fire that Jesus brought to the world.

For 2025 we have plenty of examples of God's People from all races, cultures, and religions in Los Angeles County and surrounding counties and the world helping. They have continued spreading the fire set by Junipero Serra and other brave missionaries in California.

May we help those in need right around us with our time, treasure, and whatever talents God has given to us. Just as Mr. Fred Roger's mother taught him (and us), let us "look for the helpers" in all tragedies. And by God's grace, let us all be helpers!

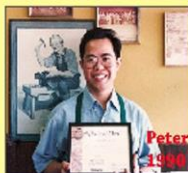
